NEW BILLS OF INTEREST

<u>S.B. No. 873</u> (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A TWO-GENERATIONAL INITIATIVE', to build upon and expand a two-generational service delivery model to achieve school readiness and workforce success. REF. HUMAN SERVICES

S.B. No. 886 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISCRETION TO GRANT OR DENY PARDONS FOR JUVENILES CONVICTED UNDER SPECIFIC CONDITIONS', to allow the Board of Pardons and Paroles to issue pardons only after a full and extensive review of all available information, receive victim input and deny an application for a pardon if necessary to protect the interests of the people in this state. REF. JUDICIARY

S.B. No. 893 (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO CERTAIN STATUTES REGARDING THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES', to (1) require or permit the Department of Children and Families to disclose certain records to certain individuals and entities without the consent of the persons who are the subjects of such records, (2) permit such department to charge a fee for the disclosure of certain records exceeding one hundred pages in length, (3) eliminate such department's Subsidy Review Board and replace such board with the provision of a hearing in accordance with chapter 54 of the general statutes, (4) require the Commissioner of Children and Families to notify certain agencies of child abuse and neglect investigations pertaining to certain employees of such agencies, and (5) require such commissioner to adopt regulations setting forth standards for the licensing of child care facilities and child-placing agencies. S.B. No. 894 (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE STATE OVERSIGHT COUNCIL ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES', to establish the State Oversight Council on Children and Families in place of the State Advisory Council on Children and Families, and require the State Oversight Council on Children and Families to report annually to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to children. REF. COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN

S.B. No. 895 (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES' STANDARDS AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS', to (1) require the Commissioner of Children and Families to establish protocols for the investigation of reports of child abuse or neglect of children from birth to three years of age, (2) issue certain reports to the Superior Court when a child or youth is committed to such commissioner, and (3) report annually to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to children regarding foster care licensing practices. REF. COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN

<u>H.B. No. 5742</u> (COMM) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THREATENING OF A JUDGE', to increase the penalties for first and second degree threatening in cases where the person making the threat knows that a person being threatened is a judge. **REF. JUDICIARY**

H.B. No. 6099 (COMM) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CHILD CARE FACILITY NEIGHBOR RELATIONS TASK FORCE', to establish a task force to study strategies for the improvement of relationships between residents of child care facilities licensed by the Department of Children and Families and residents of the municipalities in which such facilities are located. REF. COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN H.B. No. 7111 (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE RESTRAINT, SECLUSION AND PLACING IN TIME OUT OF STUDENTS BY SCHOOL EMPLOYEES', to (1) clarify the definition of physical restraint, (2) define time out, and (3) require local and regional boards of education to (A) establish policies regarding the use of time out, (B) provide certain additional training to school professionals,

paraprofessional staff members and administrators regarding the physical restraint and seclusion of students, and (C) maintain a list of crisis intervention team members at each school. **REF. COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN**

H.B. No. 7112 (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY CENTERS', to define "children's advocacy center", clarify the purposes of multidisciplinary teams established by the Commissioner of Children and Families, permit such centers to assist multidisciplinary teams in the investigation of allegations of child abuse or neglect or trafficking of children and to permit the Connecticut Children's Alliance, Inc. to provide assistance to such centers. REF. COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN

H.B. No. 7113 (RAISED) COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN. 'AN ACT CONCERNING PRENATAL OPIOID AND OPIATE EXPOSURE', to establish additional requirements for abuse and neglect investigations by the Department of Children and Families when such investigations pertain to high-risk newborns, and require individuals who are mandated reporters involved in the delivery or care of a high-risk newborn in a birthing hospital to cause a report of abuse or neglect to be made regarding such high-risk newborn. REF. COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN

H.B. No. 7121 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO THE STATE'S SAFE HAVEN LAWS', to strengthen protections for individuals caring for infants who are considered to be in the custody of the Department of Children and Families under the state's safe haven program. REF. HUMAN SERVICES

H.B. No. 7127 (RAISED) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE PARITY OF MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE BENEFITS', to enable the Insurance Commissioner to collect information to ensure the parity of mental health and substance abuse benefits to medical, surgical or other physical health benefits, and to empower the commissioner to enforce the Paul Wellstone and Pete Domenici Mental Health Parity and Addiction Equity Act of 2008, as amended, and any regulations adopted thereunder.
