NEW BILLS OF INTEREST

S.B. No. 543 (COMM) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE OF INPATIENT SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES', to require health insurance policies to provide coverage for inpatient substance abuse services with a duration of not less than fourteen days. REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE

S.B. No. 952 (RAISED) EDUCATION. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE SHARING OF FEDERAL FUNDING BETWEEN THE OFFICE OF EARLY CHILDHOOD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES', to create a means by which the Department of Social Services shall transfer federal funds to the Office of Early Childhood for purposes of funding the Care 4 Kids child care subsidy program.
