NEW BILLS OF INTEREST

S.B. No. 586 (COMM) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT EXPANDING MANDATED HEALTH BENEFITS FOR WOMEN, CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS, AND REQUIRING THAT THE COMMISSIONER OF SOCIAL SERVICES AMEND THE STATE MEDICAID PLAN TO PROVIDE EXPANDED CONTRACEPTION BENEFITS', to: (1) Expand mandated health benefits for women, children and adolescents; (2) expand mandated contraception benefits; and (3) require the Commissioner of Social Services to amend the Medicaid state plan to provide expanded contraception benefits. REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE S.B. No. 979 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING NOTIFICATION TO SCHOOLS AND INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION OF RESTRAINING ORDERS, CIVIL PROTECTION ORDERS AND STANDING CRIMINAL PROTECTIVE ORDERS AFFECTING STUDENTS', to allow a person who is afforded protections under a restraining order, civil protection order or standing criminal protective order to request that the clerk of the court provide a copy of such order, or the information contained in such order, to a school or institution of higher education which he or she attends. REF. JUDICIARY S.B. No. 980 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A VICTIM'S RIGHT TO BE REASONABLY PROTECTED FROM THE ACCUSED', to provide notice to a person protected by a restraining or protective order or foreign order of protection as to whether the subject of such order has transferred, delivered or surrendered any pistols, revolvers and other firearms or ammunition as required by law, to cause a person entering the pretrial supervised diversionary program for persons with psychiatric disabilities to immediately transfer, deliver or surrender any pistols, revolvers and other firearms or ammunition, to require a designated party, other than the defendant, to notify the victim of a crime for which the defendant applies for accelerated pretrial rehabilitation and to provide increased employment protections for employees when any order of protection has been ordered on behalf of the employee. **REF. JUDICIARY**

<u>H.B. No. 5140</u> (COMM) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENTS TO HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES', to require each health carrier that provides coverage for the diagnosis and treatment of a substance use disorder to directly reimburse a health care provider for services rendered by such provider for the diagnosis and treatment of such disorder. **REF. INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE**

H.B. No. 6002 (COMM) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING "SEXTING" BY A CHILD', to ensure that a child under a certain age, rather than just those thirteen years of age and older, may be charged with a misdemeanor for "sexting" behavior rather than a felony for child pornography. REF. JUDICIARY

H.B. No. 6887 (COMM) INSURANCE AND REAL ESTATE. 'AN ACT CONCERNING COVERAGE FOR MENTAL HEALTH CARE SERVICES AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES PROVIDED BY CERTIFIED PEER COUNSELORS', to require that certain health insurance policies cover nonmedical mental health care and substance abuse services provided by certified peer counselors. <u>H.B. No. 7240</u> (RAISED) APPROPRIATIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REPORTS ON STATE AGENCY OVERTIME BY THE OFFICE OF FISCAL ANALYSIS', to change the dates on which the Office of Fiscal Analysis is required to issue reports each year on state agency overtime. **REF. APPROPRIATIONS**

H.B. No. 7244 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A GRANDPARENT'S RIGHT TO VISITATION WITH HIS OR HER GRANDCHILD', to allow a grandparent the right of visitation with a minor child upon demonstrating to the court that clear and convincing circumstances support the granting of such visitation.
