S.B. No. 486 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING NOTIFICATION TO BOARDS OF EDUCATION OF THE RELEASE OF A JUVENILE SEXUAL OFFENDER AND A MODEL POLICY CONCERNING THE REENTRY OF SUCH JUVENILES INTO THE SCHOOL SYSTEM', to require notification to local and regional boards of education when a released juvenile sexual offender will reside in a town served by the board, and to require a model policy concerning reentry of such juveniles into the school system.
