NEW BILLS OF INTEREST

S.B. No. 515 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR AND TECHNICAL CHANGES TO VARIOUS STATUTES CONCERNING THE JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM', to permit disclosure of juvenile arrests when the offense violates school or institution of higher education policy or poses a threat to safety, to provide for the appropriate resolution of violations of sex offender registry orders by juvenile offenders, to provide information on juvenile alcohol and drug offenses to the Department of Motor Vehicles, to delete obsolete provisions of the general statutes, and to include as a qualifier for illegal possession of certain weapons a person who was adjudicated as a youthful offender for an offense that would be a felony for an adult. H.B. No. 5555 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE YOUTH VIOLENCE INITIATIVE', to include in the list of towns that may receive a Youth Violence Initiative grant the town of Waterbury.

<u>H.B. No. 5558</u> (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING JUVENILE MATTERS', to provide for the transfer of serious juvenile criminal matters to the adult docket of the Superior Court where appropriate and to repeal an obsolete provision of the general statutes. **REF. JUDICIARY**

H.B. No. 5559 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF CASES OF REPEAT JUVENILE FELONY OFFENDERS TO THE REGULAR CRIMINAL DOCKET', to require the transfer to the regular criminal docket of cases of juvenile offenders who are charged with having committed a third or subsequent felony after having been previously adjudicated delinquent for two or more offenses designated as felonies or who have injured an innocent person during the commission of a felony. <u>H.B. No. 5562</u> (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE JUVENILE JUSTICE POLICY AND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE', to implement the recommendations of the Juvenile Justice Policy and Oversight Committee concerning reforms to the juvenile justice system and to transfer juvenile justice functions from the Department of Children and Families to the Judicial Branch.
