NEW BILLS OF INTEREST

<u>S.B. No. 523</u> (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING AN ANIMAL ABUSE REGISTRY', to establish an animal abuse registry. REF. JUDICIARY

H.B. No. 5564 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE CLOSURE OF THE CONNECTICUT JUVENILE TRAINING SCHOOL', to require the Commissioner of the Department of Children and Families, in consultation with the director of the Juvenile and Family Services Division of the Judicial Branch, to jointly submit a plan relating to the closure of the Connecticut Juvenile Training School to the General Assembly.
