NEW BILLS OF INTEREST

S.B. No. 236 (RAISED) AGING. 'AN ACT PROVIDING AN INCOME TAX DEDUCTION FOR INDIVIDUALS CARING FOR ELDERLY PERSONS, CHILDREN AND DISABLED PERSONS', to provide a tax deduction for taxpayers caring for elderly persons, children and disabled persons. REF. AGING

<u>S.B. No. 237</u> (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO EVALUATE STATUTES OF LIMITATIONS FOR SEXUAL ASSAULT CRIMES', to establish a task force to evaluate time limitations for prosecuting a crime of sexual assault. **REF. JUDICIARY**

<u>S.B. No. 238</u> (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXTENSION OF THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR THE PROSECUTION OF SEXUAL ASSAULT', to extend to ten years the statute of limitations for the prosecution of certain sexual assault crimes. **REF. JUDICIARY**

<u>S.B. No. 240</u> (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT PROMOTING THE REPORTING OF CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT', to promote the reporting of child abuse and neglect by ensuring that persons who make good faith reports of such abuse or neglect are afforded certain legal protections. REF. JUDICIARY

<u>S.B. No. 244</u> (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT REQUIRING BEHAVIOR ANALYSTS TO BE MANDATED REPORTERS OF SUSPECTED CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT', to require that behavior analysts become mandated reporters of suspected child abuse and neglect. REF. HUMAN SERVICES

<u>S.B. No. 247</u> (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING PROBATE COURT OPERATIONS', to: (1) Make minor revisions to statutes governing certain Probate Court procedures, and (2) within available appropriations, provide eligibility for grants under the Kinship Fund and Grandparents and Relatives Respite Fund to certain nonrelative caregivers. **REF. JUDICIARY**

<u>H.B. No. 5246</u> (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT ELIMINATING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS IN THE CASE OF SEXUAL ASSAULT', to allow for the prosecution of sexual assault cases without time limitations posed by statutes of limitation. **REF. JUDICIARY**

H.B. No. 5255 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER ADVISORY COUNCIL', to eliminate the planned termination of the Autism Spectrum Disorder Advisory Council. REF. HUMAN SERVICES

H.B. No. 5257 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REPORTS OF ABUSE OR NEGLECT OF PERSONS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY OR AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER', to reduce from seventytwo to twenty-four hours the amount of time a mandated reporter has to file a report of suspected abuse or neglect involving a person with intellectual disability or autism spectrum disorder. S.B. No. 167 (RAISED) AN ACT CONCERNING THE REPORTING OF ADVERSE EVENTS BY HOSPITALS AND OUTPATIENT SURGICAL FACILITIES.

H.B. No. 5149 (RAISED) AN ACT CONCERNING SOBER LIVING HOMES.

H.B. No. 5218 (RAISED) AN ACT CONCERNING MINIMUM QUALITY STANDARDS FOR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS AND EXPANDED SCHOOL HEALTH SITES.
