NEW BILLS OF INTEREST

S.B. No. 400 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING GRADUATE FUNDING AND THE PROVISION OF SUPPORT AND SERVICES FOR PERSONS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY', to ensure the provision of quality services to persons with intellectual disability. REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

S.B. No. 404 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING MANDATED REPORTERS', to add certain professions to the list of mandated reporters. REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

S.B. No. 406 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH.
