March 19, 2021

Update 2021-10

A lot of activity has occurred over the last two weeks at the legislature affecting children's issues. DCF presented before the Appropriations Committee on March 5th and met with the Human Services Budget Subcommittee on March 15th to answer several questions about our budget. Also, the Committee on Children voted out several bills before their deadline on March 16th, amending many of them before the final vote.

Committee on Children
