COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT

The State of Connecticut has enacted legislation requiring law enforcement personnel to be trained on [human trafficking on an annual basis](#). To meet the training requirements several Training of Trainers (TOT) have been offered across the state to increase the state's capacity of trainers with a goal of ensuring every police department has local training resources.

To increase training capacity the Department of Children and Families (DCF) and law enforcement POST certified instructors will be conducting another 2-day Training of Trainers (TOT) for law enforcement personnel on [*Introduction to Human Trafficking in CT for Law Enforcement Personnel*](#). The curriculum includes an overview of both adult and child, and sex and labor trafficking with an emphasis on child trafficking.

The training will be held on [Tuesday, July 9, 2019](#) and [Wednesday, July 17, 2019](#) (**must attend both days**) from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Connecticut Police Academy, 285 Preston Avenue, Meriden, CT. Instruction will be provided by Tammy Sneed who [directs Connecticut's Human Antitrafficking Response Team \(HART\)](#) and lead law enforcement trainers in this curriculum.

Enrollment for this course is limited to 30 participants.
