#### Interview Report of Officer James Borrico

On 06/06/2017 at approximately 1730 hours, I met with Bridgeport Police Officer James Borrico at the WDMC Troop G office. Ofc. Borrico had come to the Troop G Barracks to provide a written statement which documented his observations and involvement in the Use of Force event which occurred on 05/09/2017 at 1000 Park Avenue, Bridgeport CT.

Prior to this meeting, I had provided a DPS-633-C Witness Statement form to Ofc. Borrico to facilitate the preparation of his statement prior to our meeting. Upon his arrival, Ofc. Borrico provided me with his pre-prepared (1-page) typewritten statement. What appears below is a summary of Ofc. Borrico's provided statement. The entire original statement is attached to this report.

On 05/09/2017, Ofc. Borrico was operating an unmarked Bridgeport Police vehicle and was traveling eastbound on Maplewood Avenue when he observed a Subaru Forester driving towards him at "a high rate of speed westbound on Maplewood Avenue near Laurel Avenue." As the Subaru turned left onto Laurel Avenue, Ofc. Borrico pulled in behind the vehicle and requested a check of the Subaru's license plate using Bridgeport Police Channel 2. BPD Dispatch responded that the vehicle was listed as a FILE 01 STOLEN VEHICLE out of Shelton, CT.

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Ofc. Borrico then switched his radio to BPD Channel 1 – the main operational police frequency – and he relayed the vehicle description, number of occupants, and the direction of travel for the Subaru. As Ofc. Borrico continued to follow the Subaru as it turned right onto Park Avenue and then turned left onto Washington Avenue.

Ofc. Borrico stated, "As I relayed this information via channel one, a marked Police cruiser maneuvered behind me at which time I immediately pulled over keyed the radio and said, "GO AROUND." (This cruiser was Amber 23 containing Officers Mario Pecirep and James Boulay.)

Ofc. Borrico described what occurred next as follows: "As the Police cruiser went around my vehicle the Subaru Forester made an abrupt right and accelerated into the parking lot of Walgreens located at 1000 Park Avenue. The Subaru Forester traveled through the parking lot at a high rate of speed and attempted to flee via Fairfield Avenue exit. Several vehicles were stopped for the red light at the intersection Fairfield Avenue and Park Avenue making the exit impenetrable. The operator of the Subaru Forester (later identified as Jayson Negron) put the vehicle in reverse accelerated and rammed the marked police cruiser (Amber 23) which was behind it. The operator of the Subaru Forester then put the vehicle in drive and hit the vehicle in front and then again reversing and hitting the marked Police cruiser (Amber 23) to the rear. After ramming the vehicle to the front and rear the Subaru Forester accelerated the wrong way on to Fairfield into several vehicles that were stopped for the red light. The Subaru Forester again accelerated forward and backward ramming vehicle(s) in its way in efforts to flee. One of the Officers from the marked Police cruiser (Ofc. Boulay) attempted to apprehend the operator of the Subaru Forester. Officer Boulay opened the driver's door of the Subaru Forester and attempted to remove the operator at which time the operator accelerated in reverse trapping the Officer's legs underneath and dragging him. Officer Boulay discharged his weapon toward the operator; this caused the vehicle to stop and enabled the Officer Boulay to get his legs out from under the driver's door. I removed the operator from the vehicle at which time Officer Boulay and I handcuffed him. Paramedics were dispatched to the scene for the operator and passenger (later identified as of the Subaru Forester who were subsequently shot."

Ofc. Borrico also documented that Ofc. Boulay was transported to the hospital for treatment of his injuries, and that he notified Captain Kevin Gilleran of a possible eye witness to the event.

Ofc. Borrico also hand lettered the license plate of the Subaru in blue ink at the bottom of his type-written statement: "CT REG. F" Ofc. Borrico marked the addition with his initials "JB."
