Interview Report of Officer Jonathan Simmons

On 06/09/2017 at approximately 1635 hours, I met with Bridgeport Police Officer Jonathan Simmons at the WDMC Troop G office. Ofc. Simmons had come to the Troop G Barracks to provide a written statement which documented his observations and involvement in the Use of Force event which occurred on 05/09/2017 at 1000 Park Avenue, Bridgeport CT.

Prior to this meeting, I had provided a DPS-633-C Witness Statement form to Bridgeport Police to facilitate the preparation of his statement prior to our meeting. Upon his arrival, the officer provided me with his typewritten statement, which is summarized below.

On 05/09/2017 Ofc. Simmons was assigned as unit "Blue 14," and was partnered with Officer Carlos Carmo Jr., when the officers responded to assist the Gang Unit with a stolen motor vehicle. At the time of that call, Officers Simmons and Carmo were on Park Avenue and Maplewood Avenue. The stolen vehicle was reported to be traveling on Laurel Avenue towards Park Avenue.

Ofc. Simmons was operating the BPD cruiser, and after hearing the radio call he began driving towards Park Avenue. As he received updates on the stolen vehicle's location, Ofc. Simmons drove down Olive Street towards Park Avenue.

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Ofc. Simmons wrote in his statement, "As I traveled down Park Avenue, I turned left onto Washington Avenue and then took a right into the second driveway into the Walgreens parking lot. As we were by the Pharmacy drive thru window, we heard the call for shots fired. Once I seen other Officer making contact with an individual (later to be identified as the passenger in the vehicle), I immediately exited my patrol vehicle and ran to them. When I got there the passenger was then on the ground and I hand cuffed him because of my training and experiences with stolen vehicles."

As he was handcuffing the passenger (Ofc. Simmons heard other officers calling out, "Blood Blood Blood" as a warning of a possible biohazard. Ofc. Simmons reported noticing blood on arm.

Ofc. Simmons gathered pedigree information from , and subsequently followed medics to Bridgeport Hospital.
