I make the following statement, without fear, threat or promise. I have been advised that any statement(s) made herein which I do not believe to be true, and which statement is intended to mislead a public servant in the performance of his / her official function, is a crime under C.G.S. section 53a-157b and is punishable by law.

On May 9th, assigned to unit B14, I, along with my partner Officer C. Carmo Jr. responded to assist the Gang Unit with a stolen motor vehicle. At the time of the call we were on Park Avenue and Maplewood Avenue. The vehicle was reported to be traveling on Laurel Avenue towards Park Avenue. I was driving and proceeded to head towards Laurel Avenue. As the vehicles directions were being called out, I turned down Olive Street to head towards Park Avenue. I did not hear much radio transmission. As I traveled down Park Avenue, I turned left onto Washington Avenue and then took a right into the second driveway into the Walgreens parking lot. As we were by the Pharmacy drive thru window, We heard the call for shots fired. Once I seen other Officers making contact with an individual (later to be identified as the passenger in the vehicle), I immediately exited my patrol vehicle and ran to them. When I got there the passenger was then on the ground and I hand cuffed him because of my training and experiences with stolen vehicles. As I was handcuffing the him, I heard a Officer say "Blood Blood Blood", I then noticed blood on the subjects arm. I heard over the radio for more units and AMR to respond. After medics arrived, I followed the medics to Bridgeport Hospital. While at the hospital I did not have much contact with the Passenger. On the scene at Park Avenue, Officer Carmo Jr. and I obtained his name, address, and date of birth. While at the hospital, the passenger stated that he did not know the drivers name, he only knows him as "2 ounce" and that he might live somewhere in Stratford.
