DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION IMPLEMENTATION ORDER To Implement Governor Lamont Executive Order 9R

Pursuant to Executive Order 9R, the Department of Consumer Protection issues the following rules and procedures for the delivery of alcoholic liquor by permittees of a liquor caterer permit:

1. That the permittee of a liquor caterer permit or his/her direct employee, when making a delivery of alcoholic liquor, must verify that the individual receiving the delivery is legally authorized to receive such alcoholic liquor, specifically that the individual is not intoxicated and has sufficient identification to show that he or she is at least twenty-one years of age. In lieu of requiring signatures, such permittees must maintain a log of all products delivered to each individual's address. Such log must note the brand name of the product, the size, the price, the number of bottles of each product or the number of drinks being provided, and the delivery address.
