

Temporary Off Premises Auction - Non-Profit Corporation (LNC)

(Permit for Non-Profit Auction – Wine Only)

Application Fee: \$10 filing fee

Permit Fee: \$25 per Day

This permit is referred to in Connecticut General Statutes, Section 30-37h (as amended by Public Act 14-111)

- A nonprofit corporation permit shall allow the retail sale of wine at auction, provided the auction is held as part of a fund-raising event to benefit the tax-exempt activities of the nonprofit corporation.
- All permits are limited to wine.
- The auction may be in-person, online, or blended.
 - An in-person auction is a traditional auction that is conducted live with the majority of bidders present. Proxy and telephone bidding allowed.
 - An online auction is conducted entirely via an online platform. The permittee and backer must ensure that no minor is able to bid, purchase, or receive the wine. The wine may be picked up by the winning bidder or delivered to the winning bidder via an appropriately permitted entity.
 - A blended auction has online and in-person components.
- Each permit shall allow the sale of wine at a maximum of twelve (12) such auction days in any calendar year, except as provided in section 30-37d.
