OLD BUSINESS:

1. Residential Stair Lift Technician License Subcommittee

A subcommittee comprised of Board Members John DeRosa and Paul Farnsworth has been formed to review current regulations and training requirements for the RSL license and make recommendation for proposed changes.

2. Substitute House Bill No. 6100 - Public Act 21-37 - An Act Concerning Department of Consumer Protection Licensing and Enforcement, Antitrust Issues, and the Palliative Use of Marijuana and Revisions to the Liquor Control Act

Discussion took place at the June 24, 2021 meeting regarding changes to Connecticut General Statutes, Chapter 393 requiring written contracts meeting certain specifications for work on private residential property by licensed tradespersons and the right to cancel timeframe prior to performing work. During this discussion, several Board members expressed their concern about the language included in this bill.

Leslie O'Brien and the DCP Legal Division will be addressing the matter regarding proposing changes in language to the wording that passed within Public Act 21-37 relating to contract requirements. Occupational licensing boards will be notified when this process is completed.
