### Legal Matters

**Docket Number:** 12-272

**Summary:** Drug Control investigated a prescription error and noted that CVS/pharmacy #623 (PCY.1244) had failed to perform a Quality Assurance review. *The Department's recommended civil penalty of \$1,000 has been approved.*

**Docket Number:** 12-271

**Summary:** CVS/pharmacy #2545 (PCY.1875) breached patient confidentiality by giving a prescription to the wrong person. *The approved agreement provides for a \$1,000 civil penalty to the pharmacy.*

**Docket Numbers:** 12-208 and 12-212

**Summary:** During a routine inspection, Drug Control cited Ryan Pharmacy (PCY.786) and Peter Griffin (PCT.4443) for multiple violations. A follow-up inspection found that several of the violations were not corrected. *The department recommended a civil penalty of \$4,000 to the pharmacy and Letter of Reprimand to the pharmacist manager and was approved by the Commission.*

**Docket Number:** 12-314

**Summary:** Stephen Papadoulis (PCT.10345) surrendered his license in November of 2011. The Department is satisfied that this pharmacist has taken the necessary steps to regain his license. He has the required record of drug counseling and negative drug screens. *The proposed agreement is typical for this kind of situation was approved.*
