Commission Action: Commissioner Carbray moved, seconded by Commissioner Chisholm and passed by a vote of 5-0 to approve the above request for a new pharmacy premise provided all the requirements set forth in the Connecticut Pharmacy and Drug Laws as enforced by the Commission of Pharmacy are met. Pending a 797 inspection.

Legal Matters

Case Number 2018-1312 Gagandeep Singh

Attorney Michael Ando presented this case. No Commissioner 'stepped down'. This case involved: The former Licensee seeks reinstatement of his pharmacist license following a voluntary surrender in June of 2018. The voluntary surrender followed an investigation by the Drug Control Division involving an alleged theft of drugs with a non-pharmaceutical substance abuse issue. The former licensee seeks reinstatement in Connecticut as a prerequisite to reinstatement in New Jersey, where the former licensee desires to practice.

Proposed Resolution: This agreement calls for a reinstatement of the former licensee's license to practice pharmacy, beginning with a five year probation period including documented substance abuse treatment at prescribed intervals, self-help group treatment, reporting, urine and/or blood screens at prescribed intervals, abstinence from substances,

Commission Action: Commissioner Carbray moved, seconded by Commissioner Inguanti and passed by a vote of 5-0 to accept and approve the aforementioned settlement agreement.

Case Number 2019-382 Health Care Pharmacy

Attorney Michael Ando presented this case. Commissioner Chisholm 'stepped down'. This case involved The Licensee is a pharmacy that has been investigated by the Drug Control Division for ownership by a non-pharmacist spouse of a prescribing practitioner in violation of Section 20-596(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, as well as a number of violations primarily stemming from a failure to have a registered pharmacist on duty during normal business hours, failure to provide direct supervision of a pharmacy technician, and permitting a person not licensed to practice pharmacy in CT to practice pharmacy.

Proposed Resolution: This agreement calls for the sale and divestiture of ownership interest in Health Care Pharmacy and Uncas Pharmacy by the owner on or before November 27, 2019, a civil penalty of \$17,000, the owner shall not own/operate a pharmacy in Connecticut unless in compliance with relevant laws and regulations, and the department shall approve paperwork regarding the sale of the pharmacy in a timely manner to expedite the process (provided new buyer has no prior history of discipline.

Commission Action: Commissioner DeFazio recused himself from the vote. Commissioner Inguanti moved, seconded by Commissioner Carbray and passed by a vote of 3-0 to accept and approve the aforementioned settlement agreement.

'First Time' Pharmacy Manager(s)

Commissioner DeFazio provided a summary of the responsibilities that a first-time pharmacy manager has and appreciated their appearance before the Commission. Commissioner DeFazio emphasized the importance of the pharmacy manager's role in contrast to the front-store manager (in many retail settings). Some responsibilities include leadership, technician registration, license renewals, and prescription error reporting.
