Legal Matters

Case Number 2019-988 Carl M. Mancini

Attorney Michael Ando presented this case. No Commissioner 'stepped down'. This case involved a former Connecticut pharmacist who engaged in violations of state and federal laws and regulations relating to drug diversion, drug abuse/excessive use, false, misleading, or deceptive representations, fraudulent or deceitful practices, and failure to report required information to the Department. The case commenced following a report to the Drug Control Division of suspected product tampering. A joint investigation commenced involving the Drug Control Division, the Drug Enforcement Agency, and local police. During the investigation, Respondent surrendered his Connecticut pharmacist license, which remains inactive. The case resulted in a guilty plea to a federal criminal charge of tampering with consumer products. Respondent is currently incarcerated in a Federal Correctional Institution.

Proposed Resolution: Counsel for the Drug Control Division proposes an agreement in which Respondent agrees that he shall never again apply for licensing as a pharmacist, pharmacy technician, or other licensing related to the practice of pharmacy or controlled substances in the state of Connecticut

Commission Action: Commissioner DeFazio moved, seconded by Commissioner Cafferelli and passed by a vote of 6-0 to accept and approve the aforementioned settlement agreement.

'First Time' Pharmacy Manager(s)

Commissioner DeFazio provided a summary of the responsibilities that a first-time pharmacy manager has and appreciated their appearance before the Commission. Commissioner DeFazio emphasized the importance of the pharmacy manager's role in contrast to the front-store manager (in many retail settings). Some responsibilities include leadership, technician registration, license renewals, and prescription error reporting.
