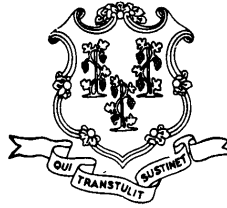

Reinstatement Instructions for Salespersons - Expired May 31, 2022

- A real estate salesperson's license may be reinstated provided a completed reinstatement form and all applicable fees are submitted **not later than two years after the date of expiration of the license**.
- Reinstatement of a salesperson's license will only be accepted if all applicable fees are paid to bring the license to the current year and required continuing education is complete. Any such reinstated license shall expire on the next succeeding **May 31st**.

Reinstatement Fees:

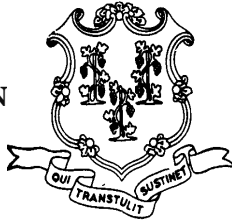
- A total reinstatement fee of **\$317.50** must accompany the completed reinstatement application. Checks/money orders should be made payable to "**Treasurer, State of Connecticut**"

Continuing Education:

- You must have completed your required Continuing Education Courses in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, Section 20-319 and provide proof of compliance to be eligible for reinstatement.

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Real Estate Continuing Education Requirements 2020 - 2022

In accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, Section 20-319, Continuing Education is due on even-numbered renewal years to be eligible for reinstatement.

- Complete 12-hours of Continuing Education courses at an approved school (online courses are available). The courses shall consist of the following:
 1. Two three-hour classes for the 2022 Mandatory CE Requirements:
 - “CT Real Estate Law for Brokers and Salespersons”
 - “Understanding and Preventing Racial Bias in Real Estate”
 2. 6 hours of real estate elective courses

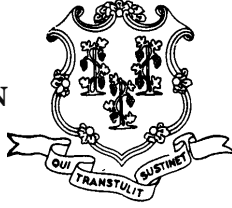
or

- Pass the Connecticut Continuing Education Examination. To take the exam, contact PSI Examination Services at www.psiexams.com or 1-800-733-9267 to schedule an exam appointment.

If you passed both portions of the Connecticut Salesperson Licensing Examination between June 1, 2020 and May 31, 2022 you do *not* need to take continuing education courses for 2022. Your PSI Examination score reports will reflect the examination passing date.
