**DN 08-233** Phamacy manager allowed unregistered techs to work as well as incorrect ratios and failure to keep certain records available for inspection. Pharmacy was issued a civil penalty; agreement for letter of reprimand to the manager.

**DN 08-218** Agreement modification – Mr. Kranc called and was not able to attend the meeting.

**DN 08-564** Prescription error investigation. The pharmacist at fault was undertremined. \$500 civil penalty
