# **Important Notice Regarding PPE for Individuals Self-Directing Services**

# **In-Person Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Events**

• Starting in January 2021 the Department of Developmental Services (DDS) will transition to monthly in person PPE events. This is to help limit exposure to harsh weather conditions during winter months. A one-month supply of PPE consisting of masks and gloves will be available for pick up by every EOR or their designee for each active staff providing waivered services. The process will not be changing, other than the frequency of events and the amount of PPE provided.

#### WHEN and WHERE will the DDS In Person PPE events be held?

- Starting in January 2021 the monthly schedule for EORs to pick up PPE will be:
  - o First Wednesday of the month (January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021) -East Hartford
  - o Second Wednesday of the month (January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021) -Stratford (EGC)
  - o Third Wednesday of the month- (January 20th, 2021) -Norwich (Uncas)
  - o Fourth Wednesday of the month- (January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021) -Southbury

Days may be adjusted due to inclement weather. # **Specialty PPE** (masks, gloves, face shields and gowns)

• The process to request and obtain specialty PPE has not changed. For individuals who meet the criteria for specialty PPE (respiratory needs such as nebulizer, CPAP, BiPAP, are COVID-19 + or presumed + or have individual unique circumstances) continue to utilize the online PPE request process and pick up these items at one of the in-person DDS locations. ### **Emergency PPE Kits**

• In addition to the in-person PPE events, earlier this month DDS began to distribute by mail Emergency PPE kits consisting of 14 Gowns, 3 Face Shields, 6 KN-95 masks, 20 gloves and 5 surgical masks to all EOR (Employers of Record). These kits should remain in the home of the individual receiving services and are for emergency use. Emergency use includes when a DDS individual, family member or their direct hire staff has tested positive and is asymptomatic or actively showing signs and symptoms related to COVID-19 or has been asked by a medical professional to quarantine due to COVID-19 exposure.
