The Department of Developmental Services (DDS) is pleased to be part of the National Core Indicators (NCI) Project. http://www.nationalcoreindicators.org/. The department is hopeful that this survey will help identify if the individuals and families we serve are satisfied with their supports and services and if there are ways we can improve. Supports or benefits received by DDS will not be affected by choosing to participate or not to participate.
