Direct Support Professionals needed!

Individuals throughout Connecticut are hiring **Direct Support Professionals!** Direct Support Professionals provide support to children and adults of all ages with developmental disabilities as they take part in everyday life – working, playing, and being involved in their community. Positions may be part-time or full-time; day, evening, weekend or overnight shifts are available.

Job duties may include: personal care; transportation to appointments; recreational activities; job coaching; respite care (giving families time away from caregiving responsibilities); and more!

What does it take to be a Direct Support Professional?

In Connecticut, anyone interested in working as a Direct Support Professional must complete College of Direct Support training, which includes mandatory training classes available online. Criminal background checks are required by DDS as part of the hiring process.

Tips for Workers

How to use www.RewardingWork.org/CT

Apply:



1. Complete a **free** online application at: **www.RewardingWork.org**
2. Go to this box: **Want a rewarding job?** Click on: **Apply now for a job!**
3. Fill out the application completely and accurately. Describe any related care experience you have, and include any training or certifications.
4. If you have a resume, you may upload it and attach it to your application.
5. After submitting your application, you'll receive a confirmation email with your username and a temporary password.

Update Your Application:



1. Keep your application active by updating it on a regular basis.
2. First, log into your application by entering your username/password in this box: **Already a member? Log in.**
3. To update your application, click **Modify** at the bottom of your application, edit or make a small change, then click **Submit**. This moves your application to the top of the list of applicants.
4. **Suspend your application** when you are not looking for work. Log into your application and check the box that says: *Suspend availability and remove from search.*
5. **Reactivate your application** when you want to find work. Log into your application and uncheck the box that says: *Suspend availability and remove from search.*

Job Board:



1. In addition to being listed in the Rewarding Work database of workers, you may also view and apply to jobs on our Job Board.
2. Click on the tab that says Job Board. Then click on the link that says "Caregivers – see available jobs."
3. Click on Connecticut to see the current list of jobs.
4. Jobs are listed in chronological order, with the newest on top. Jobs run for 30 days.
5. Click on the job posting number in red to read the complete job description.
6. If you think you are a good candidate for a position, click on the box that says "Apply to this Job" underneath the job description. You must be logged into your application/account in order to respond to a job on the Job Board.
7. The hiring consumer will receive your response by email, and will contact you if the consumer thinks you may be a good match for the position.
