## Current Resident Population – 238

Since the last meeting there were two deaths.

#### Residential

- Cottage 40 and Cottage 41 bathrooms are complete.
- Painting and wallpaper work ongoing in Cottage 41.
- Prebid meetings have taken place with elevator contractors on January 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>. We had a good response. Bids are due early next month and construction is scheduled to begin at the end of March or early April.
- Cottage 7 renovations have taken priority and all resources are now being directed at this project.
- Next closure to be announced in the coming weeks.
- Staff relocation from last round of closures is ongoing with movement to new work locations expected to be complete by the end of February.
- Possibility of approximately 13 Direct Care Staff transfers to DHMAS in the coming month.

# Budget

Budget for this fiscal year continues to be stable. Although the closure of the Fire Department is included in the budget for next fiscal year, we are continuing with our efforts to make that a more gradual process.

## Conversions
