SUBJECT: PPE Distribution to Employers of Record

DATE: October 31, 2022

Effective Fall 2022, the Department of Developmental Services (DDS) will be converting their personal protective equipment (PPE) operation to a strategic stockpile. This model will better ensure that DDS will be able to provide PPE in the event of a significant spike in COVID-19 or a similar outbreak of a life-threatening disease.

In order to facilitate this re-alignment, DDS will significantly reduce the current PPE inventory and will cease weekly distribution of PPE to DDS Qualified Providers and self-directed participants as of <u>November 16, 2022</u>. Due to this change, the in-person PPE distribution events originally scheduled for Wednesday, November 23 at Southbury Training School will not be occurring. The other **November 2022 events** scheduled from **9am-1pm** will continue for the month of November:

- 11/2 -at DDS East Hartford
- 11/9- Ella Grasso Stratford
- 11/16-at Uncus on Thames-Norwich.

Starting in **December 2022 and through January 2023** BULK PPE pick up will be made available to EORs or their designees at the locations and times below:

PICK UP TIME at all locations 9 a.m. until noon

1) DDS East Hartford (155 Founders Plaza, East Hartford):

December 7th, 2022 & January 4th, 2023

2) <u>DDS Rowland Building (55 West Main St., Waterbury):</u>

December 14th, 2022 & January 11th, 2023

3) **DDS Uncas on Thames Campus** (401 W. Thames Street, Norwich):

December 21st, 2022 & January 18th, 2023

Pre-requests through the DDS online form for **specialty PPE kits** which include: surgical grade mask or KN9; gowns; gloves; and face shields are **NO LONGER** required. Individuals who have been receiving these items due to an established respiratory need, who are susceptible to COVID 19 or who contracted COVID 19/experiencing symptoms can pick up these items in BULK as they would regular PPE kits: masks and gloves at the next 2 scheduled PPE events.
