Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

Allie’s Dream, Inc. provides individualized services to young adults between the ages of 18 and 30 with cognitive and physical disabilities, residing in the state of Connecticut, as follows:

1. Provides enrichment support to an adult day program that focuses on the following areas and specific activities for students, including but not limited to:

- a. Academic: educational day field trips
- b. Artistic: music, Zumba, dance, art, and theater
- c. Therapeutic: speech, assistive technology, physical and occupational therapies, aqua therapy, and yoga
- d. Social: interaction with other students
- e. Recreational: social outings, events, activities

2. Provides a community Saturday program, entitled “Jump into the Arts” that focuses on artistic self-expression and social networking for students. This provides respite services to families.

Allie’s Dream was established to provide a full time, individualized adult day program to serve young adults with significant developmental disabilities after their graduation from public school to enhance their quality of life and facilitate their connection to the community by providing educational, community-based and other support programs. Allie’s Dream offers one weekend day of respite care called “Jump into the Arts” and operates collaboratively with the Kennedy Center a full-time, five day a week program with all anticipated supports and services.
