#### Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

Dr. Michael Weinberg, a licensed psychologist in Connecticut and Board Certified Behavior Analyst - Doctoral is president and a co-founder of the Behavior Analyst Online Governing Board, and Behavior Analyst Online journals, and founder and president of Behavior Services of New England. He received his Ph.D. in 1985 in Behavior Analysis, and M.A. in Psychology, 1983, at Temple University, Philadelphia, PA, and B.A. in psychology in 1977 with an ABA specialization at the E.K. Shriver Center, Waltham, MA and Northeastern University. Dr. Weinberg is a licensed psychologist in three states, including PA, CT, and FL, and is a Charter Board Certified Behavior Analyst as well as Diplomate in Forensics and Lifetime Fellow of the American College of Forensic Examiners. He has over 30 years of experience in the field as a behavior analyst and psychologist, providing treatment to children, adolescents and adults with developmental disabilities, autism, emotional and behavioral disorders and various clinical diagnostic issues. Dr. Weinberg was clinical director and director of psychological services with the state of Connecticut at the Southbury Training School, as well as the Devereux Foundation's adult developmental disabilities programs in Pennsylvania and Florida Intensive Treatment Center for children and adolescents with developmental and intellectual disabilities and autism spectrum disorders. He also sub-specializes in treatment of Asperger's Disorder in the home and school settings and consults to schools to provide effective school supports for these students.

Dr. Weinberg is an adjunct Associate Professor at Endicott College's Institute for Behavioral Studies' BCBA program and adjunct faculty for the St. Joseph's University online BCBA program. He has been on the part-time faculty of Temple University, Psychology Department, adjunct at Rutgers University, and Penn State University. He has published articles and book chapters in behavior analysis in the areas of functional analysis and reactive attachment disorder. Dr. Weinberg was an appointee to the Association for Behavior Analysis International's Practice Board, a Trustee of the Cambridge Center for Behavioral Studies, and collaborated in the development of an accreditation process for programs providing ABA services. Dr. Weinberg serves as state clinical supervisor in Connecticut for an autism-specific Birth-to-Three program.
