Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

The Center of Hope Foundation, Inc. provides people with disabilities and their families the resources, services, and opportunities to be contributing members of their communities and to achieve the most fulfilling and meaningful lives possible. The agency is located in Southbridge and Sturbridge, MA. The Southbridge location borders Woodstock, CT and the Sturbridge location borders Union, CT. Transportation to and from North East CT towns is provided by the Center of Hope. The Center of Hope has four-day habilitation (DSO) programs that follow a skills training model with medical and behavioral supports that are individualized for each person. The Agency also has an Employment Services program (GSE and ISE) that provides vocational and employment skills training, direct job placement, on the job support services, and work evaluations. The Center of Hope has created small businesses to provide training and employment to the individuals we serve. Some examples of the small businesses are Hope's Treasures (a thrift store) and Just the Details (auto detailing). The Agency also has many sites where individuals can regularly volunteer. Some of the volunteer sites are at local elementary schools, local food shares, Harrington Hospital, Capen Hill Nature Sanctuary, Brimfield Public Library, 4H in Spencer, and a pet shelter/adoption facility called Here Today Adopted Tomorrow. Community integration has been limited throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, but the agency is working to establish community involvement again.
