Provider Description

Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

Center of Hope Inc. provides people with disabilities and their families the resources, services, and opportunities to be contributing members of their communities and to achieve the most fulfilling and meaningful lives possible. The agency is located in Southbridge and Sturbridge, MA. The Southbridge location borders Woodstock, CT and the Sturbridge location borders Union, CT. Transportation to and from North East CT towns is provided by the Center of Hope. The Center of Hope has three-day habilitation (DSO) programs that are open. These DSO programs follow a skills training model with medical and behavioral supports that are individualized for each person. Skills training within each site teach individuals about areas of independence such as money skills, social skills, health skills, coping skills and community safety. Community access trips allow people to be able to put the skills to practice that they learn within the program. The Agency also has an Employment Services program (GSE and ISE) that provides vocational and employment skills training, direct job placement, on the job support services, and work evaluations. Center of Hope has created small businesses to provide training and employment. Some examples of the small businesses are Hope’s Treasures (a thrift store) Just the Details (auto detailing), and our newest venture Scoops of Hope (serving ice cream). This program also provides a variety of volunteer opportunities and job readiness trainings that assist people as they build their resume. Some of the volunteer sites are at local elementary schools, local food shares, local churches, UMASS Harrington Hospital, Capen Hill Nature Sanctuary, Brimfield Public Library, 4H in Spencer, and pet shelters. Center of Hope has a peer philosophy where everyone is equal. The agency also instills an atmosphere that is centered around Positive Behavior Supports, Trauma Informed Care, and Equity, diversity, Inclusion, and Belonging.
