Originally offering supervised visits for youth in foster care, Safeway Family Services now offers supervised visitation, therapeutic support, support, and temporary care, and community-based life skills. Plans are underway to add clinical after school services, companion support and in-home services for disabled youth and adults. Raising six boys in the city of Bridgeport, Gene and Susan understand the impact positive role models, positive activities, and meaningful ways to spend time have on today's youth and families.
