Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

Goodwill Industries of Southern New England, Inc. (GWSNE), as we are known today, was born as a result of affiliations, collaborations and subsequent mergers with other community service providers in Greater New Haven. What has emerged is a progressive, community-based organization committed to its mission to enhance employment, educational, social and recreational opportunities for people with disabilities and other challenges.

GWSNE, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, is a leader in the human services industry, well known for our strong community partnerships and high quality of services.

Our services are multi-faceted and vary depending on the people served and their individual needs. Services are always person-centered and are designed and tailored as needed to best align with personal preferences and to maximize individual goal achievement and positive program outcomes.

Day and employment program services available at GWSNE include:

- Group Supported Employment (GSE) – community-based employment and training opportunities in small work crews, with full-time job coaching, supervision and related supports
- Group Day Supports (DSO) - full-time community-based retirement options for aging adults, or a blend of vocational opportunities with community and enrichment activities for individuals who prefer part-time employment but request full-time day services
- Transportation Services - provided to and from job sites and community locations for group services. For group supported individuals who cannot be transported by family or a residential provider or are unable to use public transportation, GWSNE transportation services are provided to and from residences, but may be limited to residents of the Greater New Haven area.
- Individual Supported Employment (ISE) – supports directed toward successful placement and retention in competitive employment
- Individualized Day Community (IDD/IDG) - individually tailored supports that help service recipients gain or maintain skills to participate more fully and productively in the community through work, volunteer, leisure or community activities
