MARC’s mission is to empower people with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) to make their own life choices and aid in the fulfillment of their dreams - through employment, housing, social, and community involvement and advocacy.

MARC Community Resource's Person-Centered Planning process is exemplary and ensures that each individual receives services specific to their needs that will empower their success in achieving life goals. Our programs are individually tailored and may include community experience, volunteer activities, leisure opportunities and paid work. MARC supports individuals with a wide variety of disabilities with these customized services. From group to individualized employment, to habilitation to seniors, MARC provides a unique balance of services to suit personal needs. Similarly, MARC’s living arrangements are designed to support people to not only meet their needs, but to support them to be as independent as possible. Additionally, MARC provides adult recreation, self-advocacy (MARC Guardian Angels), PPT and other school supports.
