Mosaic in Connecticut is a whole-person healthcare organization providing a wide range of services designed for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities, mental and behavioral health needs and autism through residential, day and in home supports.

Residential Services includes home-like structured support, evaluation, independent living and social/recreational skills designated by an Individual Support Plan (ISP). Supported intermittent services designed to maintain and increase independent living skills for individuals living in their own apartments. Individualized supports include assistance with banking, grocery shopping, medical appointments and accessing community, employment and volunteering. Community Companion Homes partner individuals with diverse needs with families in our communities. A focused day program serves Wallingford and surrounding areas.

Whether intermittent or 24/7 support, at Mosaic, we're passionate about services and partnerships that create meaningful lives in caring communities, giving a voice to people's needs. Mosaic's values: belonging, connection, faithfulness and grit are at the heart of our service; our direct support professionals, systems and processes ensure our individuals have access to quality care and a meaningful life. Nationally, Mosaic serves more than 5,200 people in 13 states and 750 communities.
