All of our services are person-centered and driven by the individual. Our Transitional Employment Program located in Bridgeport provides hands-on training to provide marketable skills for DDS participants interested in competitive employment. Our Day Support Option program operates in Bridgeport, Norwalk and Hartford, providing a variety of community integration programs for adults referred by DDS. Our Supported Living program helps people maximize their independence in the community by providing individualized services in their homes.

Thanks to the support of generous donors to our 22 retail stores, we operate 8 Career Centers throughout Connecticut that are free and open to the public providing a variety of employment-related services.
