Dear Rated Housing Administrator:

Effective January 1, 2020, the rated housing provider disregard, used by the Department of Social Services (DSS) when calculating benefits for the State Supplement program, will increase from \$246.70 to \$258.70.

Effective January 1, 2020, each recipient of assistance from the State Supplement program is entitled to keep up to the \$258.70 disregard, in addition to the personal needs allowance of \$29.95, for a total up to \$288.65. Because payment for January services are issued in February, this increased disregard will be first reflected in the February payment. You should retain only the approved rate for your facility.

Please note that these changes do not apply to recipients of the State Administered General Assistance (SAGA) program.
