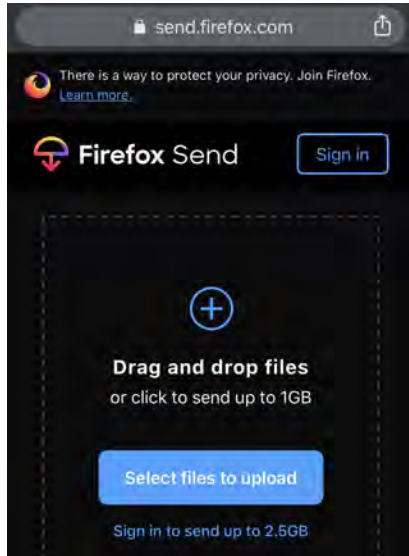


Firefox Send: Sharing High-Quality Video Files From Mobile Devices

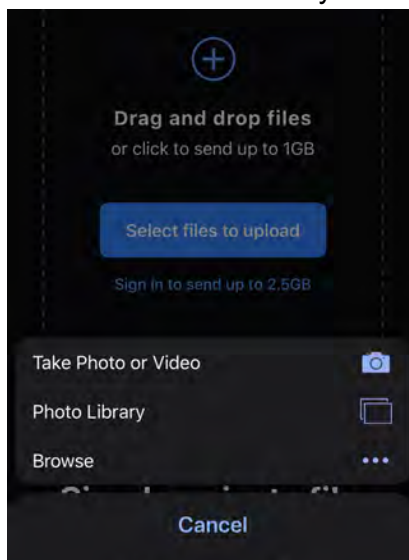
After you have recorded your video(s), you'll need to share them in a way that doesn't compress the files and lessen the quality. Unfortunately, you cannot do this via email or text message.

The solution is to use any web browser on your phone.

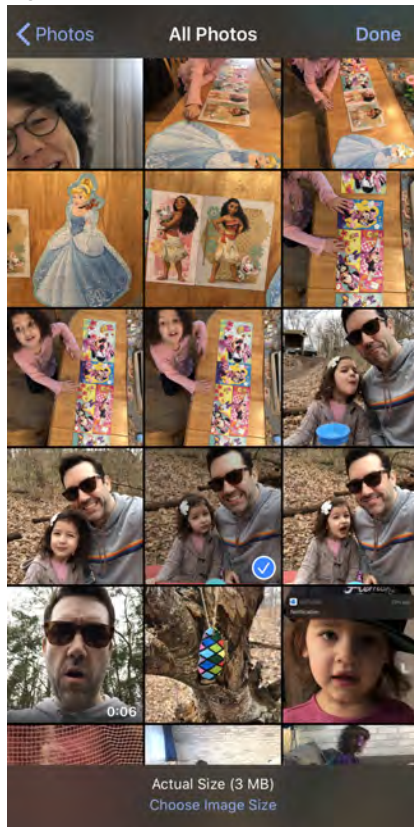
1. Go to send.firefox.com, then click the blue box that says "Select files to upload"



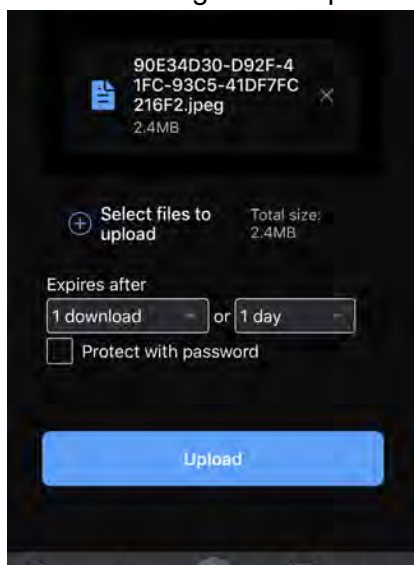
2. Choose "Photo Library" from the pop up.



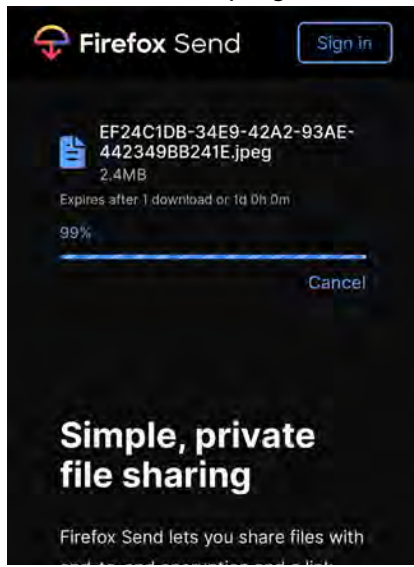
3. Select the video(s) that you recorded and want to send. Note: at the bottom of the screen, please be sure that the white text says "Actual Size." If it does not say this, click on the blue text reading "Choose Image Size" and set it to "Actual Size." When finished, click "Done" on the top right.



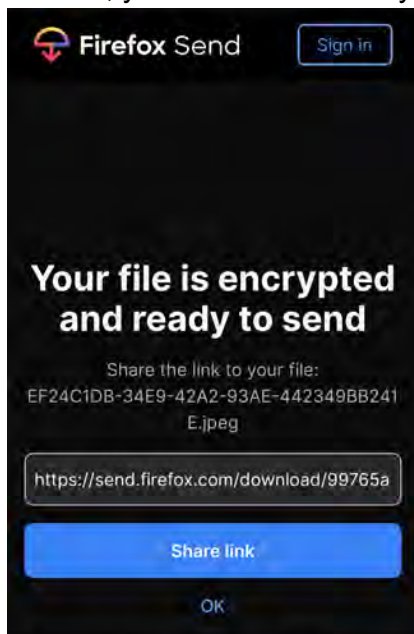
4. Click the large blue "Upload" button.



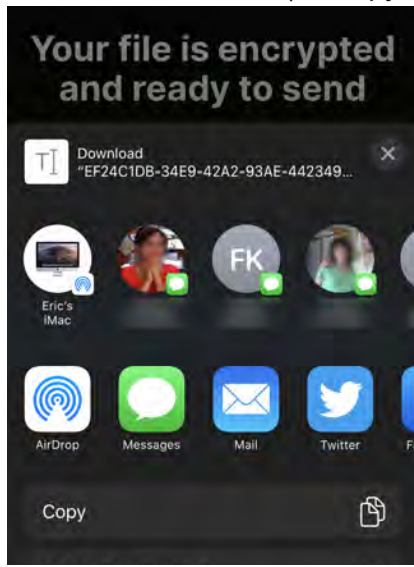
5. You'll see this progress bar:



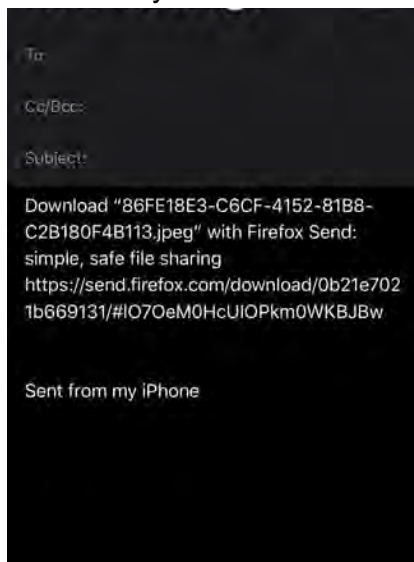
6. Then, you'll be notified that your file is ready. Click the blue "Share link" box.



7. Click the mail icon (or “copy” and you can copy and paste the link into another mail app).



8. Please send the email to eric.levesque@adamsknight.com, and in the Subject line please include the name of your attraction or business. Also please include your name in the email as well. Once you've entered this information, click “Send” and you're all done!



*Please note that you do not need to sign in or create an account. This is a free service and it allows you to send up to 1GB in a single link.
