Businesses with a DEEP General Permit Registration Allowing the Disassembly of Used Electronics

The businesses listed in the table below have registered under one of two General Permits that allow the Disassembly of used electronics, which may include covered electronic devices such as computers, monitors, printers, and televisions:

- The General Permit for Disassembling Used Electronics ("GP DUE"); or,
- The <u>General Permit to Construction and Operate a Commercial Facility for the Management of Recyclable Materials and Certain Solid Wastes</u> ("Commercial GP").

The first of these general permits only applies to companies that engage in the disassembly of used electronics and covered electronic devices and accumulate 5,000 kilograms (11,000 pounds) or more of <u>Universal Waste</u> onsite at any one time.

The second of these general permits applies to companies that engage in the disassembly of used electronics and also engage in other activities involving solid waste (such as shredding of documents for security purposes).

Companies that do not accumulate more than 5,000 kilograms or more of Universal Waste onsite at any one time and do not receive or process any other type of waste may disassemble used electronics without a permit from DEEP. However, such companies may not shred, crush, heat, or otherwise treat used electronics or any component thereof, and may not break the cathode ray tube of any used electronic device.
