



Public Hearing Information Proposed Emission Standards for 2027 model year and later Light Duty Vehicles

The Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) has received a request for hearing for the <u>proposed regulation adoption of Regulation of Connecticut State</u> <u>Agencies section 22a-174-36d</u>, Advanced Clean Cars II (ACC II) Rule.

Description. This public hearing pertains to the regulatory proposal concerning the adoption of the California Low Emission Vehicle (LEV IV) and Advanced Clean Car II (ACC II) regulation. The regulatory proposal adopts RCSA section 22a-174-36d to include provisions for more stringent emission requirements for light-duty and medium-duty internal combustion engines (ICE) in passenger vehicles and implement requirements for vehicle manufacturers to progressively increase the sale of advanced technology vehicles including battery electric vehicles from 2027 through 2035. Section 22a-174-36d contributes significantly to the State of Connecticut meeting its greenhouse gas reduction goals and federal Clean Air Act (CAA) air quality objectives.
