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Executive Summary

The Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (“DEEP”) has prepared this report to satisfy the reporting requirements of Section 16-245ee of the General Statutes to evaluate:

- (1) The funding distribution for the conservation and load management (“C&LM”) programs administered by Eversource and The United Illuminating Company (“UI”), which together will be referred to as the electric distribution companies or (“EDCs”); and
- (2) The funding distribution by the Connecticut Green Bank (“the Green Bank”, formerly the Clean Energy Finance and Investment Authority) to drive investment and scale up clean energy deployment in Connecticut for calendar years 2014 and 2015.

All residential, and commercial and industrial (“C&I”) customers contribute to the C&LM fund by paying a surcharge on their electric bill that combines the “3 Mill Charge” (established in 2000) and an additional 3 mills in the form of a Conservation Adjustment Mechanism (CAM) (established in 2013). Together, these two collections are referred to as “C&LM collections”. Customers can apply for and receive incentives funded by these collections to reduce the costs of implementing energy efficiency and clean energy measures.¹ Section 16-245ee requires DEEP to examine the disbursement of these incentives for their equitable distribution on and after January 1, 2012 and annually thereafter.

This report considers whether funding has been distributed on an equitable basis during calendar years 2014, and 2015 to “small load” customers in distressed census tracts. Specifically, this refers to customers with a maximum, average, monthly peak demand less than one hundred kilowatts, in tracts where “the median income is not more than 60% of the state median income”.² Throughout this report, these tracts are referred to as “distressed census tracts”.

In many applications of “equitable distribution,” the division of resources is not intended to be “equal” but rather, “fair.” In this review, DEEP has evaluated “equitable distribution” on the basis of proportions of contributions made versus proportions of incentives received. In other words, a census tract receiving a greater than or equal percentage of total incentives than that same tract’s C&LM contributions as a percentage of total collections would have achieved equitable distribution. For an EDC to have achieved equitable distribution, small load distressed census tracts in its territory will collectively meet that definition.³

Although not required by 16-245ee, DEEP will expand its review of equitable distribution for customers that have an average monthly peak greater than one hundred kW’s (large load) in distressed census tracts, and residential customers vs. C&I customers in distressed census tracts.

At DEEP’s request, the EDC’s also have provided residential data on the Home Energy Solutions (HES) and the Home Energy Solutions-Income Eligible (HES-IE) programs as an indicator of the

level of participation achieved by each company in 2014 and 2015 with residential customers in distressed municipalities, according to housing stock.

Conclusions

On an overall basis, the two EDCs achieved equitable distribution by disbursing a greater proportion of total incentives to customers with small loads, in distressed census tracts than the proportion of total collections received from those same customers in years 2014 and 2015 (Table I). The Connecticut Green Bank does not technically meet the threshold of equitable distribution as defined in this report but DEEP acknowledges that it is by a 1% or less margin. This report is serving as a record of historical data and DEEP will reserve any analysis of trends and how they correspond to current programmatic adjustments and funding changes for the 2016-2017 equitable distribution report.

DEEP has noted areas with inconsistent reporting and acknowledges that these often are the result of vague statutory direction or procedural changes, and that there is a need to improve the evaluation process. In order to ensure fair and consistent evaluation of both annual and trending progress, DEEP plans to work with the EDCs and the Green Bank in 2018 to refine the analysis process for the future. This may include reporting standardization, proposals for statutory revision, and establishing more specific requirements for equitable distribution.

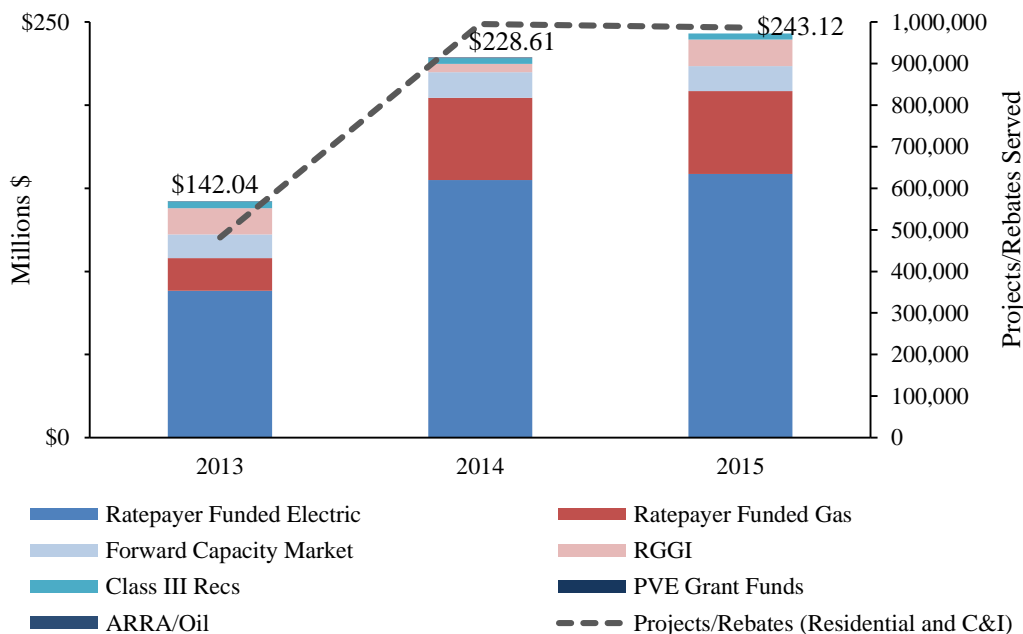

Background

In 2013, Public Act 13-298 amended Connecticut General Statutes 16-245m(d) and directed PURA to establish a fully reconciling Conservation Adjustment Mechanism (CAM) of \$0.003/kWh collections in order to fund increased energy efficiency investment. Subsequently, the CEEF budget increased from \$142.04M in 2013 to \$228.61 in 2014, a 60% increase.⁴ This increase has transformed the conservation and load management plan’s programs.

For comparison, the chart below demonstrates how that increase in funds expanded the participation by both residential and C&I customers statewide. In 2013 there were approximately 481 thousand projects or rebates distributed to ratepayers across the state, but following the establishment of the CAM, that number grew to nearly one million projects. This has allowed the programs to better serve Connecticut, and increase energy savings across fuel types.

Figure 1: Changes in Available Funding Between 2013 and 2015



This report assesses the collection of these revenues by census tract, as well as disbursement by census tract. Pursuant to Section 16-245ee of the C.G.S., before approval of any C&LM plan submitted by the Energy Efficiency Board (“EEB”) or any plan for renewable energy projects submitted by the CGB, DEEP is tasked with determining whether or not funds are equitably deployed to economically distressed tracts. DEEP is required to submit its report and resulting determination to the Joint Legislative Committee on Energy and Technology on an annual basis. As utilities are not able to provide revenue and incentive disbursement data until the close of the calendar year, DEEP must retrospectively review trends in equitable distribution before approving a plan.

The 2013-2015 C&LM Plan Decision included two conditions of approval germane to DEEP's annual review of the equitable distribution. Condition No. 8 of the C&LM Plan Decision stated:

DEEP directs [Eversource and UI] to track relevant data on a census tract basis or report to DEEP what steps they are taking to comply with the requirement to track data on this basis.

In addition, Condition No. 9 stated:

On or before June 1, 2014, and thereafter annually on March 1, each EDC shall submit to DEEP and the EEB a table containing data for the prior calendar year that includes, on a census tract basis or, if not available by census tract, on a town-by-town basis, the amount of conservation program funds assessed and the amount of incentives expended, disaggregated as small or large customers according to the one hundred kilowatt peak demand threshold, and further disaggregated by customer class (i.e. Residential and C&I). Additionally, on or before June 1, 2014, and thereafter annually on March 1, each EDC shall submit to DEEP and the EEB a table further disaggregating the residential data component from small customers as follows: specifically the residential data component for small customers shall be disaggregated by the HES and HES-IE programs, and identify the total number of project participating in each program, and disaggregate those project numbers by housing stock (i.e. single family, multi-family (2-4 units), and multi-family (>4 units)). The EDCs shall work together to produce a table format that presents the data from each of the companies in a consistent manner.

These conditions have guided the reporting format for the past several years but may be modified going forward to streamline and improve analyses and data transfer.

DEEP Methodology for Evaluation

The C&LM programs administered by the utilities are not funded solely by proceeds from 3 Mill Collections (see Table 2 below). Likewise, the Green Bank's renewable energy projects are funded by more than just the Renewable Energy Investment charge of \$.001/ kWh ("Collections") on the EDCs' electric bills. Other funding sources that also support the total budgets for those programs include auction proceeds from the sale of Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative ("RGGI") allowances, grant funds, Forward Capacity Market proceeds, and more (Table 2).⁵ Furthermore, funds and incentives are allocated not only to programs that benefit specific customers or communities, but also to programs and expenses that have a generalized impact across Connecticut, such as administrative costs, planning, research and development programs, and education and outreach programs. Therefore, the contributed amounts cannot be expected to match the expended funds for a given census tract the C&LM programs and projects. Additionally, the total amount of incentives allocated to a given census tract is not directly controlled by the EDCs

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or by the Green Bank. Rather, fund allocation is driven by the level of customer participation in a given census tract.

The Collection amounts in the context of this report represent just the revenues collected through the C&LM Program charge on customers' electric bills. By contrast, the incentive amounts represent the disbursements from C&LM budgets that also include, as explained earlier, other sources of funding. A breakdown of the electric C&LM funding for 2014 is provided in Table 2.⁶

Revenues from the sources listed in Table 2 are aggregated and distributed across the CL&M programs. Isolating ratepayer revenues for this analysis is difficult, therefore DEEP deemed it more reasonable to evaluate equitable distribution by:

- (1) Separating customers into the following categories for each EDC: small load distressed census tracts, large load distressed census tracts, small load other tracts, and large load other tracts, where "other" indicates a non-distressed tract;
- (2) Then calculating each customer grouping's 3 Mill contributions amount as a percentage of their EDC's total amount of 3 Mill Collections;
- (3) Then calculating that same customer grouping's incentive disbursement as a percentage of their EDC's total incentives disbursed;
- (4) Then finally comparing the two resulting percentages for equitableness.

For example, to consider the equitableness of what small load residential customers in distressed census tracts had contributed in 3 Mill Collections as a group, versus what that same group received back collectively in incentives, a percentage would be calculated for each of those amounts as a ratio to the total 3 Mill Collections and incentives for all small load residential customers.

In the past, equitableness was evaluated by comparing the contributions and incentives received by census tract as a percentage of the total of their specific category (i.e. all small load, residential, distressed tracts in Eversource territory). Although C.G.S. section 16-245ee includes a determination by DEEP that funds have been equitably distributed based on census tract, ratepayer incentives are distributed by program, and are not set aside for projects specifically in their census tract's category. To more effectively compare the contributions to the participation, DEEP has assessed the ratios by company, as customers from Eversource territory cannot access funds raised by UI customers, and vice versa.

For calendar years 2014 and 2015, equitableness will be defined as a census tract receiving incentive disbursements proportions that are greater than or equal to that same tract's 3 Mill contribution proportion. For an EDC to achieve technical equitable distribution, the distressed census tracts in its territory will collectively meet this standard. Potential determinants to be analyzed in future reports include return on investment ("ROI") and percent-of-income comparisons between economic groupings. For future reports, DEEP will examine trends and assess the ability to provide a specific percentage for determining equitable distribution. In the Appendices of this report, DEEP provides tables to present these calculations for each EDC.

Analysis of Equitable Distribution 2014

EDCs Overall 2014

Below is a chart that specifically identifies each company's success in 2014 in achieving equitable distribution compliant with CGS section 16-245ee. As this is historical data and will not impact current energy policy decisions, the following analyses, tables and graphs are purely observational and will serve as a record for comparison in future reports.

Though the utilities are assessed individually, DEEP has conducted an analysis of the equitable distribution of C&LM funds overall to gain perspective on statewide performance. In 2014, a greater proportion of incentives were distributed than were received in collections from distressed census tracts.

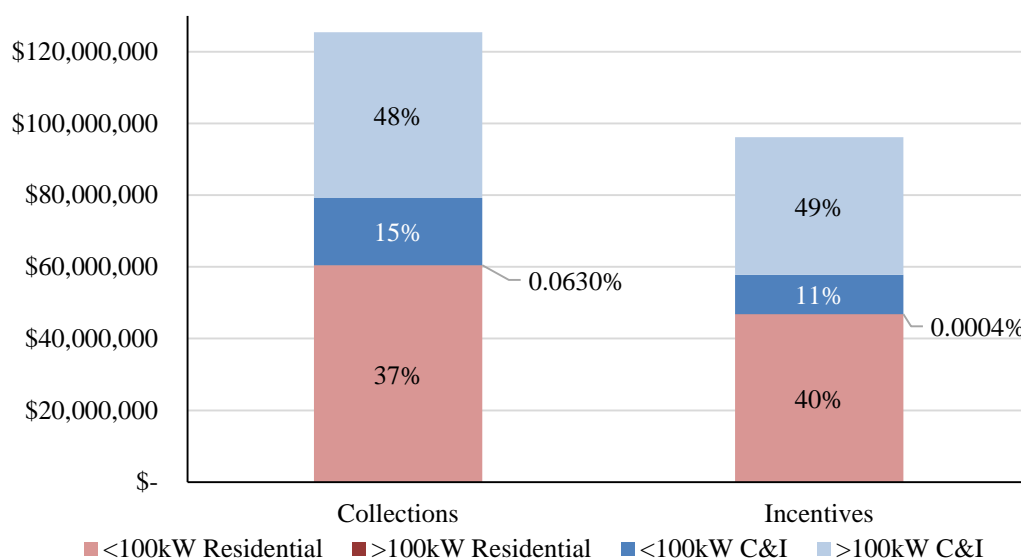

In 2014 CL&P customers contributed 80% of total, statewide C&LM collections, and received 81% of total, statewide incentives.

Experian was used to match the census tracts with customer billings, and then calculate the contributions and incentives for each tract. Only tracts where 100% of the population was below 60% of SMI were considered distressed. Of its 605 total census tracts, CL&P identified 27 census tracts in nine towns as distressed. This is largely the same as 2013 with the exception of census tracts 5104 (East Hartford) and 3512 (Waterbury) being removed from the list, and 4173 (New Britain) being added in 2014.

For the purposes of this report, DEEP has found that collectively, CL&P’s small-load, distressed census tracts received a greater proportion of incentives than their contributions. However, on a census-tract-by-census-tract basis, only eight of the 27 distressed census tracts with small load customers met the equitable distributions standards. A summary of these tracts collections and incentives is listed in Table 6 below.

Overall, customers in these 27 tracts contributed 0.85% of the total CL&P collections and received 0.86% of its incentive disbursements. On an individual census tract basis, the table above identifies those tracts that warrant additional focus in the future to ensure and increase participation. DEEP notes that these proportions of the totals are respectively 70% and 80% lower than in 2013. In 2013, small load, distressed, C&I customers contributed over \$685k and received \$957k in incentives, whereas those numbers were essentially zero in 2014. As the number of distressed census tracts have not changed dramatically, this is likely explained by a move towards upstream incentives for manufacturers rather than direct customer incentives. This enables consumers to pay a discounted price for energy efficiency measures at the point-of purchase which lowers the cost for both the consumer and overall program operations. The 2014 Annual Update of the 2013-2015 Electric and Natural Gas Conservation and Load Management Plan outlined this strategy as a key tool going forward for both residential and C&I customers. As a result, it is not necessary

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to compare the trend over the two years as this is a result of a programmatic change, rather than a lack of participation.

Large load, distressed tracts (greater than 100kW) demonstrated similar results. Overall, large load customers across classes contributed 37% of collections but received 40% of incentives (Table 10).

However, Table 10 also shows that large load, distressed customers did not receive any incentives according to the reporting, and only contributed 0.01%. As previously stated, this is likely the result of a transition away from direct incentives, towards upstream incentives for many measures. For reference, these same categories of customers contributed \$1,895,891 million and received \$1,903,187 in direct incentives in 2013.

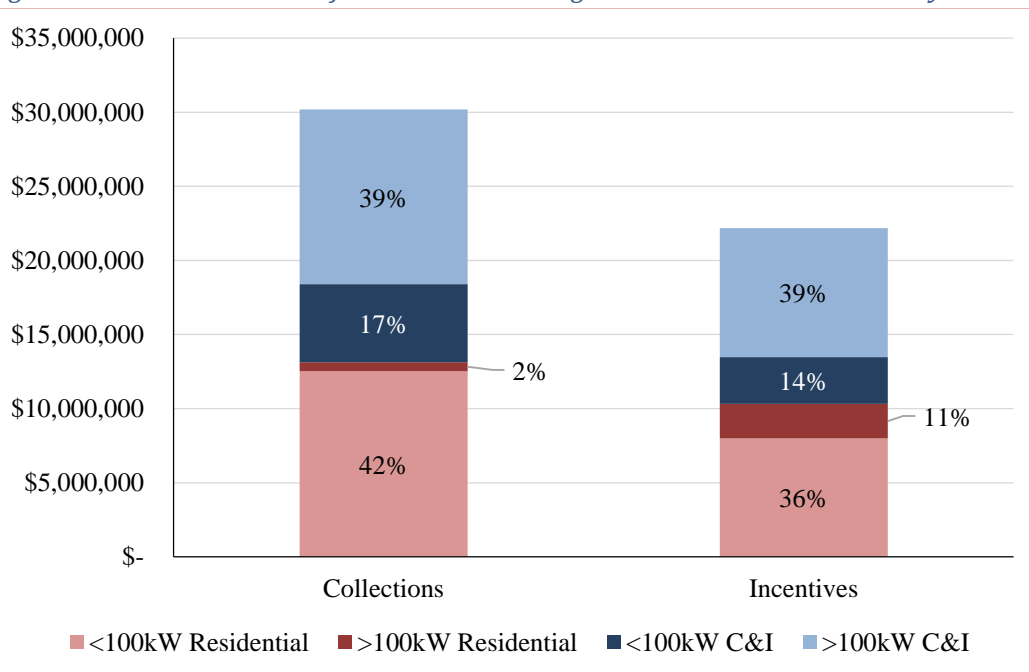

On an overall basis United Illuminating customers contributed over \$30 million dollars, amounting to 19.39% of total 2014 collections, and received 18.74% of total incentives.

Across its 18 towns and 175 census tracts, UI identified 48 distressed census tracts in five of those towns. Like CL&P, this is consistent with 2013 with the exception of 0701 (Bridgeport) being added and 0711 and 1803 being removed.⁷ When disaggregated by income level, United Illuminating customers in distressed census tracts contributed 23% to the total collections, and received 26% of total incentives (Table 11).

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However, DEEP’s analysis reveals that UI did not achieve equitable distribution to small load customers in distressed census tracts in its territory as shown by Table 12.

Small load customers in distressed census tracts contributed 12% of UI collections, but received only 9%, the majority of which was distributed in Bridgeport and New Haven census tracts due to strong multifamily pushes in those towns. Additionally only 12 of the 48 distressed census tracts with small load customers in UI territory achieved equitable distribution as shown in Table 13. DEEP recommends that UI increase education and outreach efforts to customers within these census tracts to raise awareness about program offerings to achieve equitable distribution.

Comparatively, UI's large load customers achieved equitable distribution, as shown in Table 16. This is primarily attributed to the fact that despite contributing only 41% of total UI collections, these customers received about half of the incentives. Large load, C&I customers in distressed tracts received a substantial portion of the incentives in particular, receiving over 300% more incentives in 2014 than 2013. This is likely explained by the higher number of distressed tracts in UI territory than in Eversource, the greater concentration of large industries and multifamily housing centers in southern Connecticut, and the fact that C&I customers pay a lower rate.

Home Energy Solutions (HES) 2014

While it is not required by statute, DEEP requested the EDCs to provide data on the total amount of incentives paid under the Home Energy Solutions (HES) program and the Home Energy Solutions- Income Eligible (HES-IE) program separately. This data is also broken down into single and multi-family unit participation. This allows for a closer look at each EDC's penetration of the residential marked in distressed census tracts.

In 2014, every CL&P customer from a distressed census tract that wanted to participate in the Home Energy Solutions (HES) program was serviced by the Home Energy Solutions-Income Eligible (HES-IE) program meaning that they received all the services provided through HES at no cost. These customers received about 3% of the total HES-IE incentive allocations in CL&P's territory.

United Illuminating served more customers in distressed census tracts with HES-IE program incentives than with HES. It is possible that households in a distressed census tract would not meet the income eligibility requirement of being less than 60% SMI. The threshold for determining which census tracts are distressed also includes households that are 60% of SMI (rather than just less than that percentage). Still, customers in distressed census tracts received about 28% of the total HES-IE incentive allocations in UI's territory.

The incentives allocated to residential customers in distressed census tracts are lower than what was collected from those same customers in each company's territory in each company's territory, but HES-IE is just one of the services available for customers to utilize the available funds.

Connecticut Green Bank 2014

DEEP analyzed the Green Bank’s efforts in achieving equitable distribution separately from the utilities, but utilized a consistent methodology. The Green Bank operations are partially funded by a 1 Mill Collection charge on utility customer’s monthly bill, in addition to many other forms of funding. The Green Bank received approximately \$26 million in 1 mill collections and distributed over \$33 million in incentives across 4,560 projects in 2014. The Green Bank does not track the per-census tract contributions as the utilities do, but DEEP has simply extracted these amounts by considering the fact that as the total collections are technically a total of 6 Mills, the 1 Mill Contribution is equal to one sixth of that.

Historically, the Green Bank and the EDCs have had some incongruities in which tracts were reported as “distressed”. Further, of UI’s 48 distressed census tracts, the Green Bank only shares 23, and only 14 of CL&P’s 27. DEEP has analyzed the Green Bank’s data purely on its own reported data but encourages the Green Bank and the utilities to coordinate their methods for consistently identifying distressed census tracts. Based on these reports, DEEP has found that technically the Green Bank did not achieve equitable distribution by 1% in 2014. However, significant programmatic changes have occurred since 2014 and DEEP will reserve any conclusions or recommendations for the 2016-2017 report when a more thorough analysis of trends can be considered (Table 21).

Analysis of Equitable Distribution 2015

EDCs Overall 2015

In 2015, the EDCs collected \$155 million through the 3 Mill Collections and the CAM, and disbursed \$108 million in incentives for energy efficiency projects. Customers in distressed census tracts contributed approximately 1% to the fund and also received about 1% of the incentives. These figures are consistent with 2014 reporting and suggests that utilities are making efforts to maintain equitable distribution of incentives. DEEP will evaluate these findings further on a company by company basis in this section.

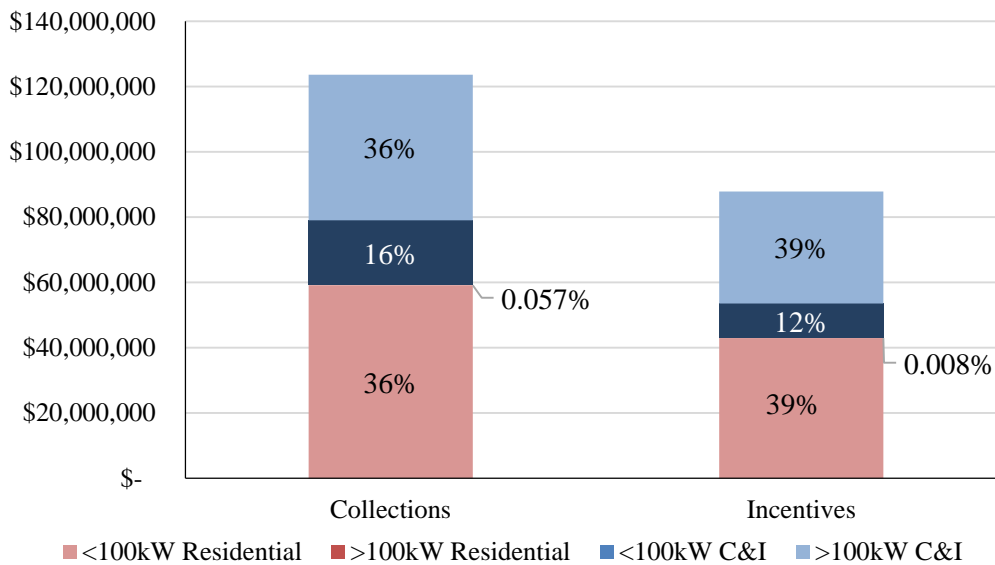

In 2015, Connecticut Light and Power officially began doing business as Eversource Energy, and therefore for the remainder of this report, DEEP will refer to CL&P as “Eversource.”

In 2015, Eversource reported 27 census tracts out of its 724 total, as distressed. Experian was used to match the census tracts with customer billings, and then calculate the contributions and incentives for each tract. Only tracts where 100% of the population was below 60% of SMI were considered distressed. This is consistent with previous filings.

Eversource distributed an equivalent proportion of incentives to small load, distressed census tracts to what it received in collections from those customers (Table 25). On a census-tract-by-census-tract basis, Eversource achieved this in 6 out of the 27 distressed census tracts (Table 26). Also, Eversource’s other customer classes received incentive proportions approximately equivalent to their collection contributions. DEEP encourages these positive trends and that Eversource continue to pursue equitable distribution across all of its census tracts moving forward.

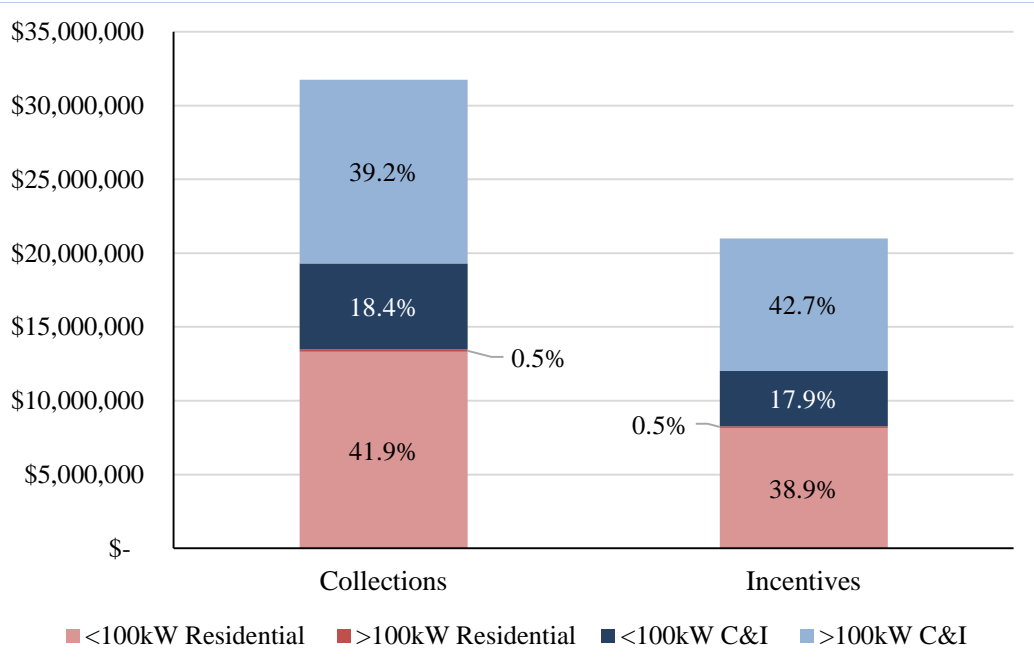

In 2015, customers in distressed tracts in Eversource's territory were primarily serviced through the Home Energy Solutions- Income Eligibly (HES-IE) program, which provides customers below 60% SMI the same services as the Home Energy Solutions (HES) program at no cost. Customers in distressed census tracts received approximately 3% of total incentives used for HES-IE services overall. The 27 distressed census tracts are similarly about 3% of the total number of tracts in Eversource's territory.

In United Illuminating's territory, customers in distressed census tracts were also primarily serviced through HES-IE, receiving about 40% of the total incentives used for HES-IE services, and about 9% of HES incentives. DEEP notes that 48 distressed census tracts make up about 26% of the total tracts, and that majority of units served were in multifamily buildings.

DEEP has determined that distribution of HES-IE and HES services to be equitable as households qualifying for the no-cost program are not limited to just distressed census tracts. Overall, more money was allocated to low-income HES services than were collected from residential customers in distressed census tracts.⁸ It is clear that both utilities are making significant efforts to provide low or no cost HES services to their customers in distressed census tracts through their HES-IE program funding.

Connecticut Green Bank 2015

In 2016, the Green Bank provided DEEP with detailed records documenting the distribution of funds, and credit enhancements across the state which allowed a more granular consideration of distribution practices than in previous years. The Green Bank is partially funded by a 1 mill Collection charge on utility customer's monthly bill, but does not track the expenditure of the charge explicitly. DEEP estimated that the Green Bank received approximately \$26 million in 1 mill collections and distributed over \$23.6 million in direct incentives across 7,494 projects in 2015. However, this amount does not entirely reflect the private investment leveraged using the 1 mill collections.

Based on these estimates and reported incentive allocations, DEEP has determined that the Green Bank did not achieve equitable distribution of its incentives in 2015 by a 1% difference. Again, DEEP will reserve conclusions and recommendations for the 2016-2017 report when a more thorough analysis of trends can be considered.

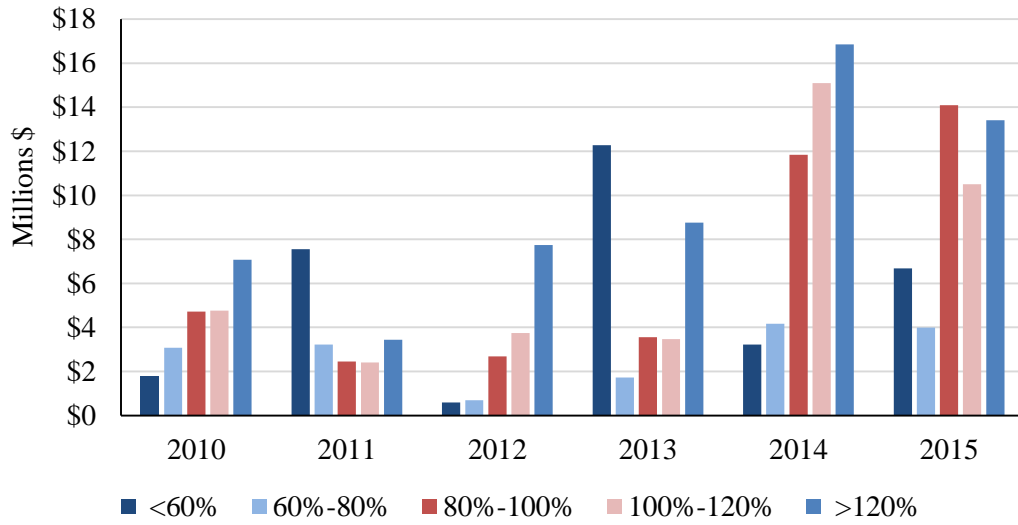

It should also be noted that the Green Bank has increased its incentive distribution to distressed census tracts over the past six years, as shown in Figure 6 below. DEEP encourages this trend to continue especially as Connecticut continues to pursue greater clean energy access for low income communities.

Conclusions and Recommendations

On an overall basis, DEEP has found that the two EDCs and the Connecticut Green Bank achieved equitable distribution by disbursing a greater proportion of total incentives to customers in small load, distressed census tracts than the proportion of total collections received from those same customers in years 2014 and 2015. The EDCs and the Green Bank are achieving equitable distribution even though contributions also fund other program costs such as administrative costs, research and development, marketing, etc., and not all disbursements are funded only by 3 Mill collections. Therefore, this evaluation is comprehensive and reasonable for this two year period.

However, many changes have occurred on the state level and programmatic level since 2015 and opportunities exist to improve the evaluation process. DEEP plans to work with the EDCs and the Green Bank to streamline and refine the reporting and evaluation process. The companies and the Green Bank can expect a request for improved consistency in reporting mechanisms, and increased communication between them and the Department. DEEP will reserve any relevant recommendations for the 2016-2017 report which DEEP expects to complete in 2018.

APPENDIX A

Past Context

Prior to passage of Section 101 of Public Act 11-80, neither the EDCs nor the Green Bank were compelled by any directive to compile relevant data along census tract parameters. Given the circumstances at that time, the EDCs submitted their data on a town-by-town basis, and DEEP conducted its evaluation for the 2010 and 2011-2012 Equitable Distribution Report (“2010 ED Report, 2011-2012 ED Report”) using the economically distressed municipalities list published by the Department of Economic and Community Development (“DECD”) as a proxy in the absence of the census tract-specific criteria.

In 2012, DEEP began to anticipate that the C&LM program participation could result in wide variances in spending levels across the state, year to year. For example, smaller towns could experience extreme variations due to commercial customer program participation in a sparsely populated community. While the EDCs were still unable to report data on census tract basis, they found that they were able to disaggregate data according to the one hundred kilowatt peak demand threshold in each municipality and by customer class (residential vs. C&I). As a result, DEEP began requesting that the EDCs additionally present the required data according to such parameters.

This explanation may appear incongruous with previous DEEP directives which established that data must be submitted on such terms starting in 2014. The reasoning for this is that the utilities submitted both the 2011 and 2012 data in such a way that it made more sense for DEEP to do a joint assessment of those years.

Past Methods of Census Tract Identification

Prior to the 2013 report, the EDCs did not produce data organized by census tracts. For both the 2010 and the 2011-2012 reports, DEEP condoned the submission of required data on a town-by-town basis using the DECD’s 2010 list of distressed municipalities, as defined by Conn. Gen. Stat. § 32-9p(b).⁹

In response to Condition Nos. 8 and 9 of DEEP’s approval with conditions of the 2013-2015 C&LM Plan, CL&P and UI achieved the technological capability to submit 2013 data on a census tract basis. For each census tract in their respective service territories, each EDC provided: (1) the amount contributed through the \$.003 per kilowatt hour (“kWh”) C&LM charge on customers’ electric bills (“3 Mill Collections”) in 2013; and (2) the amount of incentives disbursed by the EDCs from funds for C&LM programs in 2013.¹⁰ For each census tract, customers were split into

two groups according to usage: small load customers (customers with an average monthly peak demand of 100kW or less), and large load customers (customers with an average monthly peak demand greater than 100kW). Moreover, with each size grouping, CL&P and UI further disaggregated the data by customer class (residential customers and commercial and industrial (“C&I”) customers). Lastly, the EDCs identified the census tracts within their respective service territories wherein the median income is not more than 60% of the state median income for small and large customers with a maximum average monthly peak demand of 100kWh, as defined by Sec. 16-245ee. For the purposes of this report, the qualifying census tracts so identified will be referred to as “distressed census tracts”.

In a joint letter filed August 20, 2014, the EDCs provided a narrative further explaining the processes they used to comply with the Orders. While both the EDCs achieved similar equitable distribution data submissions, they acknowledged that they employed differing information technology engagements to arrive at the data that incorporated census information to identify distressed census tracts.

CL&P obtained census tract and distressed census tract information directly from Experian.¹¹ As for UI, it first associated each meter with its latitude and longitude, and then identified the distressed census tract based on the 2012 American Community Survey Five Year Estimates, which were released by the U.S. Census Bureau in December 2013. UI was then able to assign a census tract to each meter, thereby identifying the meters that are within the distressed census tracts. Thereafter, the information technology departments of both EDCs processed billing data and census tract information into separate databases to create their respective 2013 equitable distribution data submissions.

Additionally, at DEEP’S request, CEFIA submitted an Excel workbook of approved program projects during calendar year 2013 that included details relevant to equitable distribution such as project identifiers, locational data (census tract and municipality information) and incentive disbursements.

The narratives and information provided by the EDCs and CEFIA were deemed adequate by DEEP for the 2013 Report’s purposes. However, as DEEP’s evaluation of the data has become more detailed, it requested that the EDCs and CEFIA provide an additional explanation of their distressed census tract identification methods for this 2014 report. Specifically, DEEP felt it was

tracts, DEEP will generally display just the first 4 digits of the last 6 numbers of a given geographic identifier (“GEOID”) if the last 2 digits are zeroes. 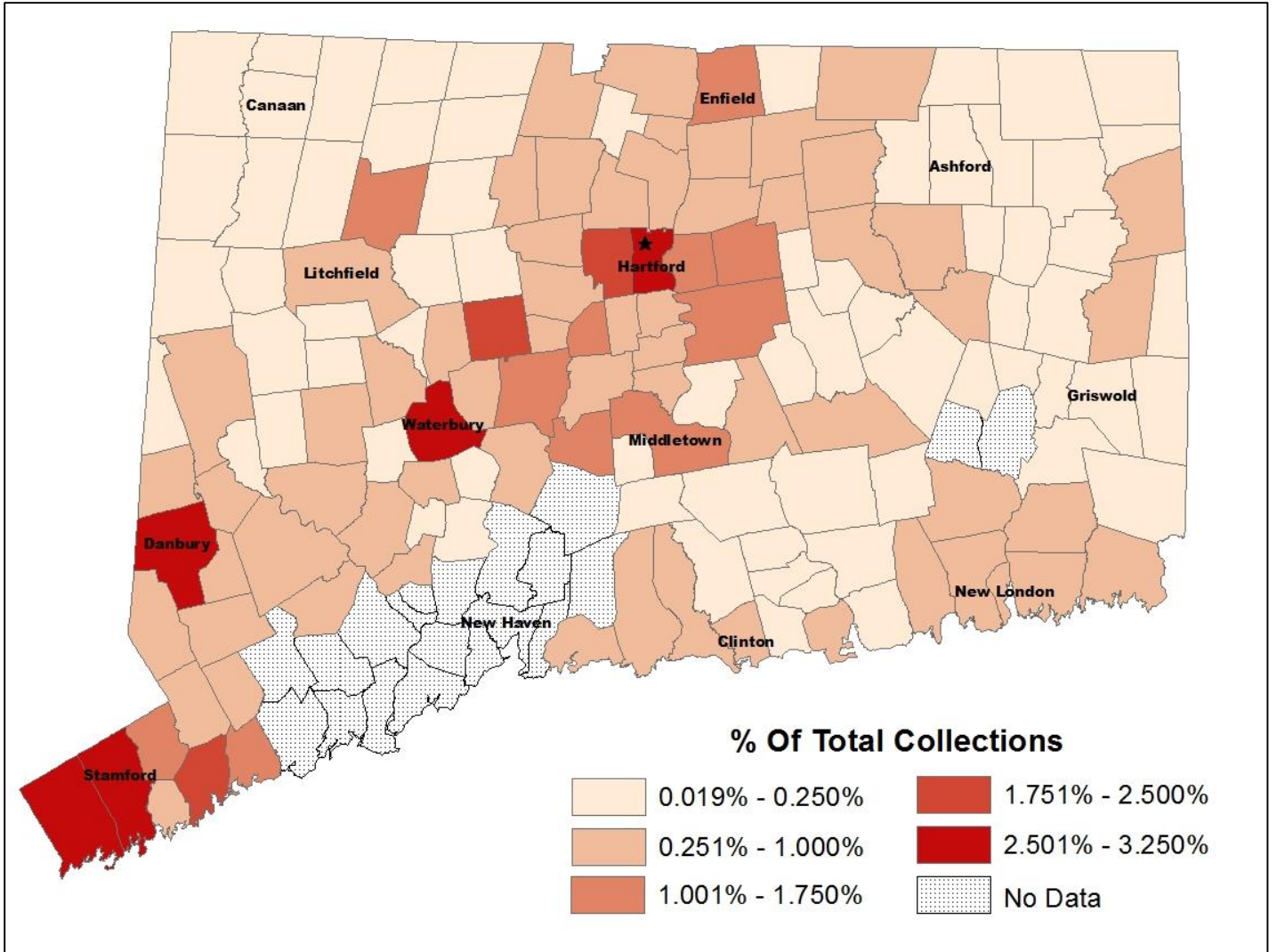

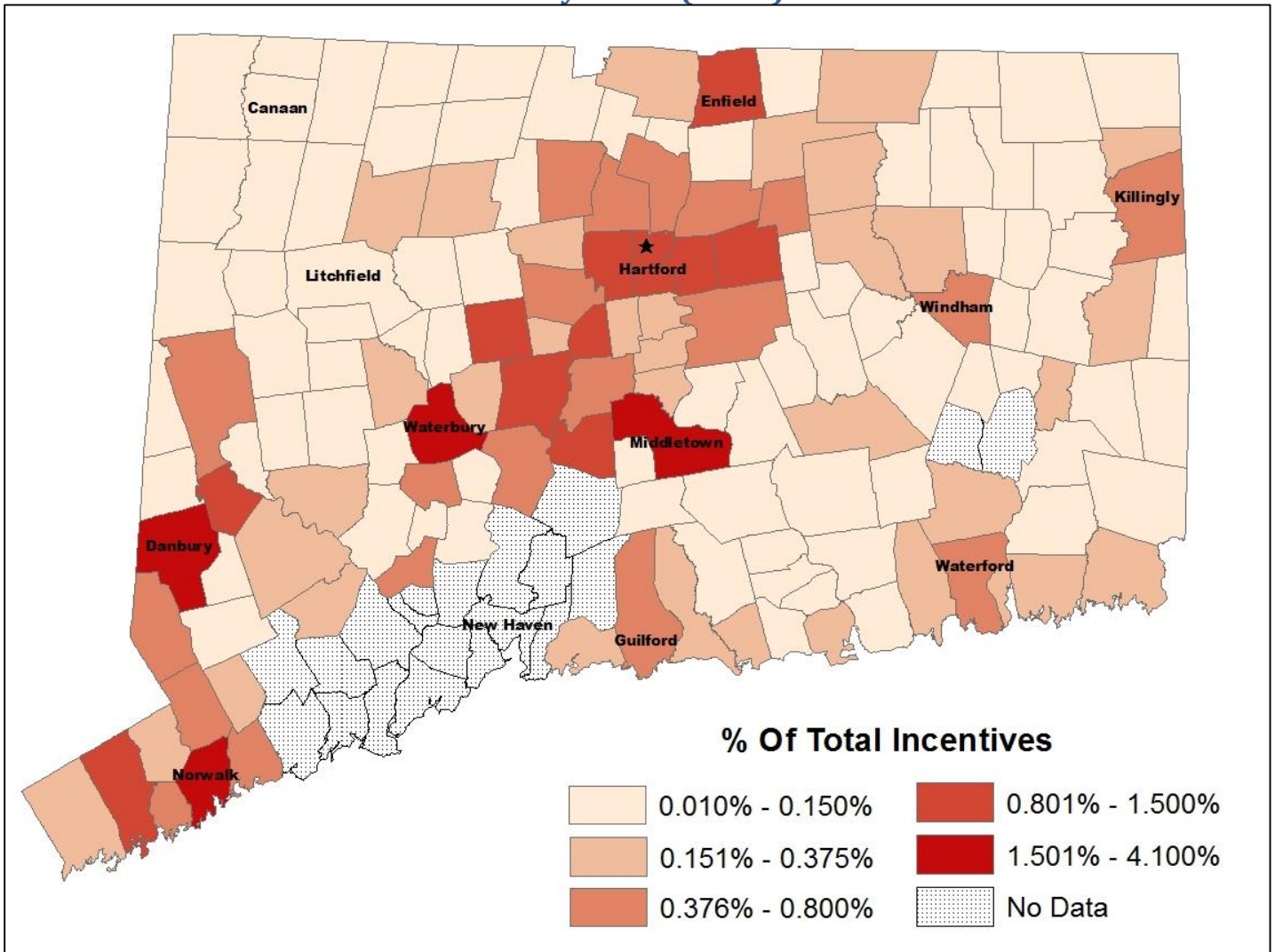

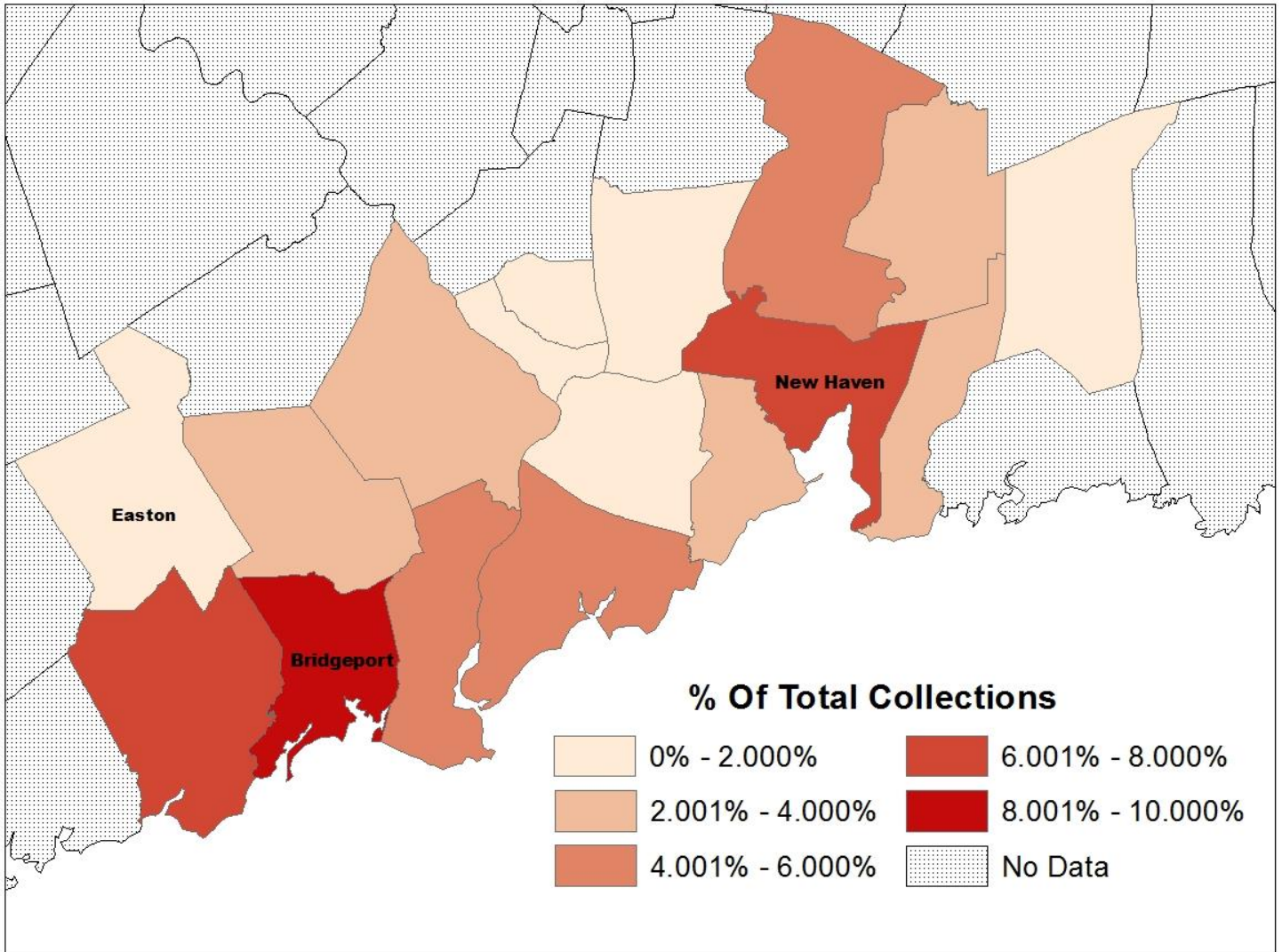
Eversource Collection Contributions by Town (2014)
