**CT GENERAL STATUTES – SECTION 16-245m(d)
2019-2021 CONSERVATION AND LOAD MANAGEMENT PLAN**

Notice of Public Informational Meeting and Opportunity for Public Comment

The Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) is hosting a public informational meeting and offering a public comment period regarding the proposed 2020 Plan update, dated November 1, 2019 of the *2019-2021 Conservation and Load Management Plan: Connecticut's Energy Efficiency and Demand Management Plan*". This Plan was submitted by Eversource Energy (Eversource), The United Illuminating Company (UI), Connecticut Natural Gas Corporation (CNG) and The Southern Connecticut Gas Company (SCG), pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes section 16-245m, in consultation with the Connecticut Energy Conservation and Management Board [aka the Connecticut Energy Efficiency Board or the EEB]. DEEP will issue separately an agenda of topics DEEP is looking for public comment on to help inform the DEEP decision on the 2020 Plan Update. The meeting will be held on **December 12, 2019 beginning at 9:30 a.m. in Hearing Room 2, at DEEP's offices at 10 Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut.**
