During the closed Season: Sep 8-Nov 28, both dates inclusive, possession of lobster taken from Long Island Sound (LMA 6) is prohibited. Beginning Nov. 15 <sup>th</sup> , gear may be redeployed but traps cannot be baited until Nov. 22 <sup>nd</sup> Minimum size: 3 3/8"
<b>American shad</b>	<b>CLOSED</b> Opens April 1 <sup>st</sup>		Open: April 1– June 15, except weekends. American Shad may be taken in the Connecticut River only. Maximum gillnet soak time = 4 hours
<b>Atlantic menhaden</b>	<b>OPEN</b>	12,000 lb <sup>1</sup> 120,000 <sup>2</sup>	<sup>1</sup> Call-in required when in possession of more than 6,000 lb. <b>Whelk</b>	<b>OPEN</b>		<b>Minimum size effective 01/01/2024: 5" shell length or 2" shell height.</b>






## 2024 Weekly Black Sea Bass Landings for Quota Monitoring




## 2024 Weekly Bluefish Landings for Quota Monitoring
