

From the East: Take I-95 South to exit 34. Turn right onto Rte. I south fir 0.5 miles. Turn left onto Naugatuck Avenue at the traffic light. Turn right onto Milford Point Road at the traffic light. At sharp bend in road turn/stay right to continue on Milford Point Road to end. Take drive on right at end of the road to reach the Center

From the West: Take I-95 North to exit 33, which is Ferry Boulevard. Continue onto Rte. I north across the Housatonic River into Milford. Turn right onto Naugatuck Avenue at the light. Turn right onto Milford Point Road at the light. At sharp bend in road turn/stay right to continue on Milford Point Road to end. Take drive on right at end of the road to reach the Center
