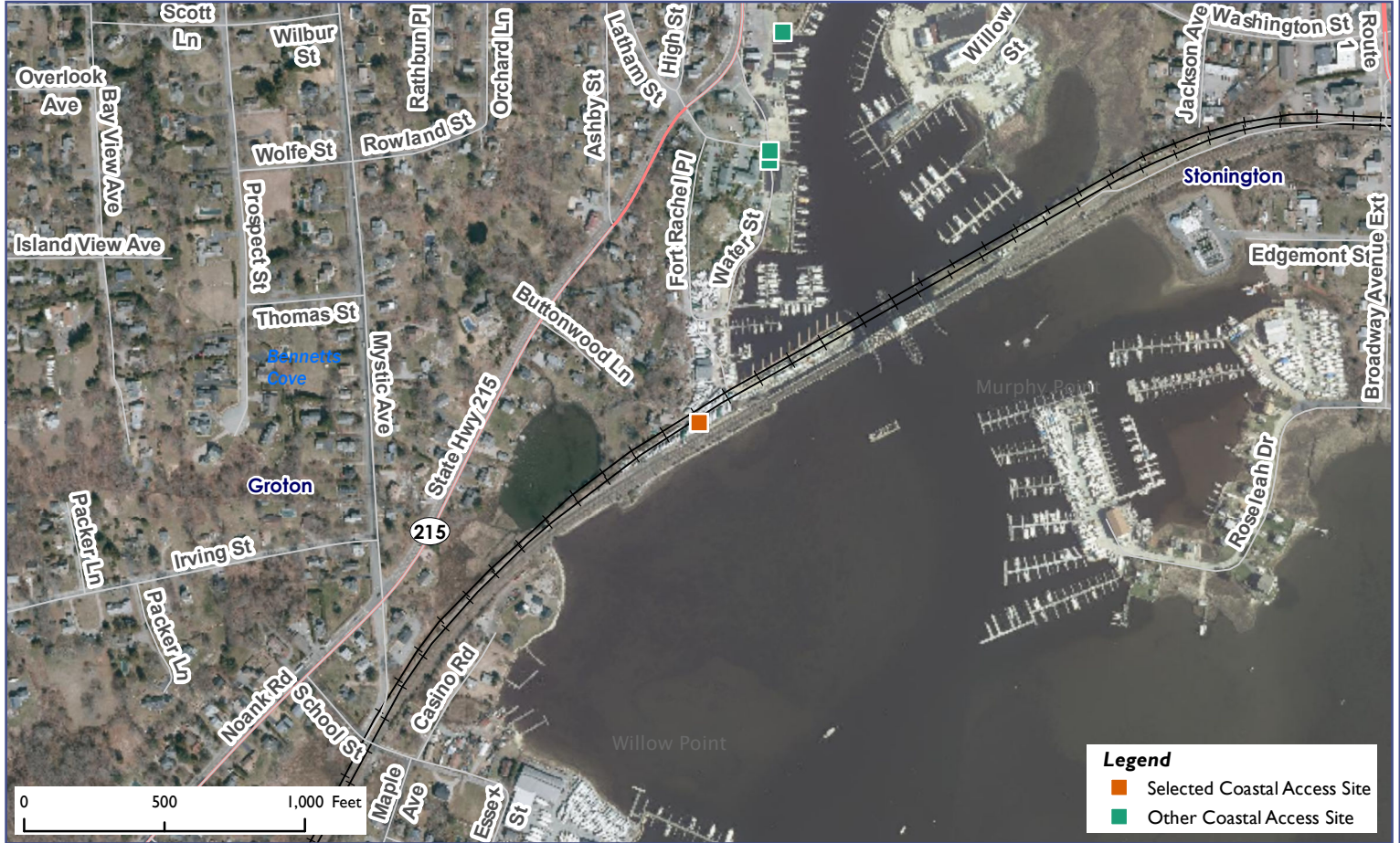

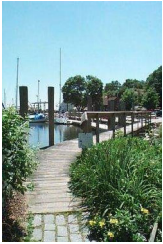

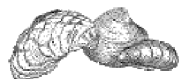
Legend

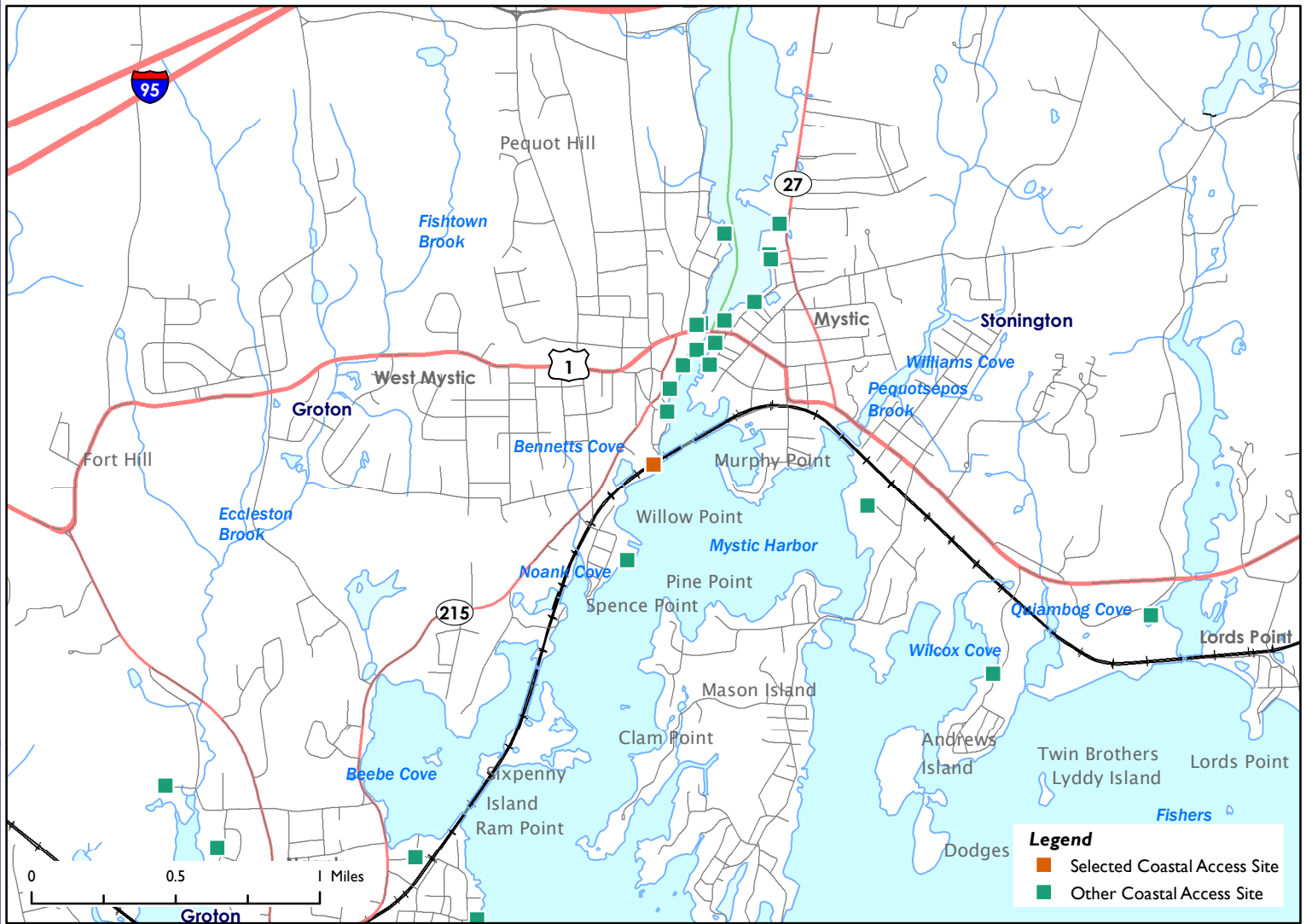

From the East: Take I-95 South to exit 89. Get onto Mystic Street/Route 614. Follow until you reach West Main Street. Turn left onto West Main Street. Turn slight right onto New London Road. Follow until intersection with Route 215. Turn left onto Water Street.

From the West: Take I-95 North to exit 89. Get onto Mystic Street/Route 614. Follow until you reach West Main Street. Turn left onto West Main Street. Turn slight right onto New London Road. Follow until intersection with Route 215. Turn left onto Water Street.
