Site Description: The Tidal Marsh Trail (TMT) is a half-mile hiking trail, located off Universal Drive N in North Haven, CT, that follows the eastern shore of the Quinnipiac River. The trail is fairly level, well-maintained, and features some unique views of the river and its wetlands. It also offers an opportunity for outdoor activities ranging from bird watching, to fishing, to canoeing and kayaking. The site is clearly marked and accessible behind the Target located on Universal Drive N. in North Haven, CT. There is one sign along the drive that points individuals towards trail head. Dogs are allowed on-leash and biking is permitted. This trail is maintained by the North Haven Trail Association.



Directions:

From the East: Take I-95 South and then use the right 3 lanes to take Exit 48 onto I-91 N toward Hartford. Follow this for 4.7 miles and then take Exit 9 for Montowese Ave. Turn left onto Montowese Ave and go ~400 feet before turning right onto Universal Drive N. Travel 0.3 miles, then turn left onto Eagle Xing. Follow Public Access signs to behind the Target, where there is a parking lot near the trail head.

From the West: Take I-95 North and then use the right two lanes to take Exit 48 for I-91 toward Hartford. Travel on this for 4.2 miles, then take Exit 9 for Montowese Ave. Turn left onto Montowese Ave and go ~400 feet before turning right onto Universal Drive N. Travel 0.3 miles, then turn left onto Eagle Xing. Follow Public Access signs to behind the Target, where there is a parking lot near the trail head.
