



ANNOUNCEMENT – UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK REGULATIONS – STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

The [Department of Energy and Environmental Protection \(“DEEP”\)](#) is planning to propose changes to Connecticut’s Underground Storage Tank (“UST”) Regulations applicable to state and federally regulated USTs [[sections 22a-449\(d\)-1 and 22a-449\(d\)-101 to 22a-449\(d\)-113, inclusive, of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies](#)], commonly referred to as the UST Regulations. To initiate the regulation revision process, DEEP plans to hold a stakeholder engagement for interested parties to provide input on the concepts for a proposed regulation change.

Making changes to the regulations has been a priority for DEEP since 2014 in order to add clarity to the UST Regulations. It is anticipated that a comprehensive evaluation and revision to the UST Regulations will result in a consolidated regulation, inconsistencies identified, and corrective actions formulated and undertaken. Such an effort to “cleanup” the UST Regulations has not been undertaken in many years. Revisions to the UST Regulations will help UST Owners and UST Operators better understand the requirements as well as minimizing threats to human health and the environment.
