

The Environmental Protection Agency's Proposed Approval of Connecticut's Revised Underground Storage Tank Program

The Connecticut State Underground Storage Tank (UST) program applied to the EPA for approval of revisions to its UST program. The EPA has determined that revisions to the Connecticut UST program satisfy all requirements for approval. The EPA has published a Proposed Rule and Direct Final Rule in the Federal Register dated July 14, 2022.
