- Purpose: receive assistance from DEP without enforcement action or fines levied
- Scheduled visit performed by DEP inspection staff with Hoya personnel
- Friendly, comprehensive DEP services including technical assistance / pollution prevention
- Hoya requested audit of its South Windsor facility a "RCRA non-notifier" currently

What Happened During the Audit?

- Opening Meeting
- On-site walkthrough / tour of the facility
 - ✓ Review of all site operations and manufacturing processes
 - ✓ Evaluation of wastes generated by process and management technique
- Evaluation of On-site Documentation
 - ✓ Shipping Records (e.g., manifests)
 - ✓ Documentation of HW Determinations
 - ✓ Waste profiles (e.g., types and quantities of waste generated)
- Closing Meeting
 - ✓ DEP summarized audit results
 - ✓ DEP discussed SQG -vs- LQG requirements with added wastestreams pending installation of new processes / equipment
 - ✓ Hoya received CESQG guidance and other outreach materials

What were the Results/ Outcomes?

- Saved Hoya from hiring consultant at \$90/ hr.
- DEP provided comprehensive audit report
- Hoya conducted HW Determinations as recommended by DEP
- Results of analyses yielded non-hazardous waste for all wastestreams
- Hoya's RCRA generator status remains unchanged for now— as a RCRA "non-notifier" or "CESQG"
- Movement of operations from Bethel to South Windsor expected to affect waste generation / status

Hoya-specific Compliance Objectives

- Document annual HW Determinations for new and existing wastestreams
- Establish "Environment Subcommittee" with key personnel to evaluate materials usage, maximize reuse of materials and minimize waste generation
- Maintain compliance with closure of Bethel facility and successful consolidation in South Windsor
