-  New format for major “topic” pages. Some sub-pages provide the results of a web search (links); some provide more substance; and some have been reorganized/enhanced/consolidated.
-  Finding out that it’s not called the World Wide Web for nothing! Need to work within government guidelines, formatting constraints, demands on staff time, organizational challenges, DOIT web filters, etc.

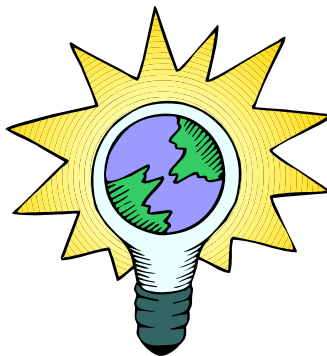
