Notice is hereby given that the State of Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (CT DEEP) is making available the draft *State of Connecticut Integrated Water Quality Report* for public review and comment (Public Notice) from **June 6, 2022 to July 6, 2022**. This Report was prepared by the CT DEEP to fulfill requirements of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA) under Sections 305(b) and 303(d). The final document will be submitted to the federal Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) following the Department's consideration of comments received.
